Associations of "Routinely" (30 Words)

accepted	Generally believed or recognized to be valid or correct. <i>The accepted consensus within the church.</i>
<u>accustomed</u>	Customary; usual. <i>His accustomed thoroughness.</i>
always	For all future time; forever. <i>She is always making derogatory remarks.</i>
basically	In the most essential respects; fundamentally. <i>He is basically dishonest.</i>
<u>broadly</u>	In general and without considering minor details. <i>He was grinning broadly.</i>
<u>chiefly</u>	Mainly. <i>He is remembered chiefly for his organ sonatas.</i>
commonly	Under normal conditions. <i>Shift workers commonly complain of not getting enough sleep.</i>
<u>consist</u>	Be consistent in form tenor or character be congruous. <i>The information perfectly consists with our friend s account.</i>
customarily	By custom; according to common practice. <i>The leaves are customarily used for animal fodder.</i>
<u>essentially</u>	In essence; at bottom or by one’s (or its) very nature. <i>The argument was essentially a technical one.</i>
<u>ever</u>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>Did you ever smoke.</i>
exceptionally	To an exceptional degree. <i>The weather was exceptionally mild for the time of the year.</i>
<u>generally</u>	Usually; as a rule. <i>The best scheme is generally reckoned to be the Canadian one.</i>

habitually	By way of habit; customarily. <i>He habitually carried a pocket knife.</i>
infrequently	Not many times. <i>He cooks but only infrequently.</i>
largely	On a large scale. <i>These accounts are largely inactive.</i>
mainly	For the most part. <i>He is mainly interested in butterflies.</i>
mostly	In large part; mainly or chiefly. <i>I made some good friends but mostly met closed minded people.</i>
normally	Under normal conditions. <i>Try to breathe normally.</i>
ordinarily	In a normal way. <i>A person who is ordinarily resident in the United Kingdom.</i>
overwhelmingly	Incapable of being resisted. <i>The country voted overwhelmingly for independence.</i>
pantechnicon	A large moving van (especially one used for moving furniture).
predominantly	Much greater in number or influence. <i>Predominantly Russian areas.</i>
primarily	Of primary import. <i>This is primarily a question of economics.</i>
principally	For the most part. <i>He was principally a landscape painter.</i>
regularly	Frequently. <i>Make a point of regularly consulting the noticeboard.</i>
typically	In a typical manner. <i>The quality of work is typically very high.</i>
universally	Everywhere. <i>Progress is not always universally welcomed.</i>
usually	Under normal conditions. <i>Heat resistant paints are usually black or aluminium coloured.</i>
wont	Make or be or become accustomed. <i>He was wont to arise at 5 30 every morning.</i>
