low	Of a vowel pronounced with the tongue held low in the mouth open. <i>The sun is low</i> .
marathon	A footrace of 26 miles 385 yards. She s embarking on a marathon UK tour.
quickly	With speed. <i>He works quickly.</i>
rider	A small weight positioned on the beam of a balance for fine adjustment. A rider was also added the question of liability was dependent upon the purpose of the disclosure.
runner	A plant that spreads by means of runners. The van was a good and reliable runner .
running	Executed or initiated by running. As mountain stream with freely running water.
<u>sprint</u>	A quick run. A sprint planning session.
