canter	Ride at a canter. <i>The men cantered away.</i>
cycling	The sport of traveling on a bicycle or motorcycle.
dart	Shoot an animal with a dart typically in order to administer a drug. <i>A dart of panic.</i>
dash	The longer signal of the two used in Morse code. <i>Waves were dashing against the rock.</i>
declension	The inflection of nouns and pronouns and adjectives in Indo-European languages. <i>The first declension in Latin.</i>
descending	Coming down or downward. <i>A passage of descending chords.</i>
downswing	The downward movement of a club when the player is about to hit the ball. <i>Your body must not sway to the left during the downswing.</i>
exercise	Cause an animal to take exercise. <i>She still exercised every day.</i>
fall	A waterfall or cascade. <i>It is their husbands fault if wives do fall.</i>
falling	Decreasing in amount or degree. <i>A falling market.</i>
flit	Move house or leave one's home, typically secretly so as to escape creditors or obligations. <i>Moonlight flits from one insalubrious dwelling to another.</i>
gymnastics	Exercises developing or displaying physical agility and coordination The modern sport of gymnastics typically involves exercises on bars beam floor and vaulting horse. <i>These vocal gymnastics make the music unforgettable.</i>

hiking	A long walk usually for exercise or pleasure. <i>She enjoys hiking and climbing in her spare time.</i>
hurry	A condition of urgency making it necessary to hurry. <i>Hurry it s late.</i>
jog	A spell of jogging. <i>He set off along the bank at a jog.</i>
jogger	A person who jogs as a form of physical exercise. <i>There are joggers on every road.</i>
jogging	Denoting a garment designed to be worn while jogging. <i>Some gentle jogging for a few weeks before the event should prevent any aching or stiffness.</i>
jumping	The act of jumping propelling yourself off the ground. <i>The jumping was unexpected.</i>
low	Of a vowel pronounced with the tongue held low in the mouth open. <i>The sun is low.</i>
marathon	A footrace of 26 miles 385 yards. <i>She s embarking on a marathon UK tour.</i>
quickly	With speed. <i>He works quickly.</i>
rider	A small weight positioned on the beam of a balance for fine adjustment. <i>A rider was also added the question of liability was dependent upon the purpose of the disclosure.</i>
runner	A plant that spreads by means of runners. <i>The van was a good and reliable runner.</i>
running	Executed or initiated by running. <i>As mountain stream with freely running water.</i>
sprint	A quick run. <i>A sprint planning session.</i>
stride	Significant progress especially in the phrase make strides. <i>Great strides have been made towards equality.</i>
stroll	A victory or objective that is easily achieved. <i>We took a stroll in the garden.</i>
stroller	Someone who walks at a leisurely pace. <i>Shady gardens where strollers could relax.</i>
trainer	An aircraft or simulator used to train pilots. <i>A decent pair of trainers.</i>

walker

A light enclosing framework (trade name Zimmer) with rubber castors or wheels and handles; helps invalids or the handicapped or the aged to walk.
A fell walker.
