**coronary** Obstruction of blood flow in a coronary artery by a blood clot thrombus.

A disease in which the body's ability to produce or respond to the

diabetes hormone insulin is impaired, resulting in abnormal metabolism of

carbohydrates and elevated levels of glucose in the blood.

embolism Obstruction of an artery, typically by a clot of blood or an air bubble.

One patient died of a pulmonary **embolism**.

erythrocyte

A mature blood cell that contains hemoglobin to carry oxygen to the bodily

tissues; a biconcave disc that has no nucleus.



**alucose**A syrup containing glucose and other sugars made by hydrolysis of starch

and used in the food industry.

A hemoprotein composed of globin and heme that gives red blood cells

their characteristic color; function primarily to transport oxygen from the

hemoglobin lungs to the body tissues.

Fish have simpler **hemoglobin** than mammals.

**hypertension** A state of great psychological stress.
