## Associations of "Sacrificed" (30 Words)

<b>altar</b>	A table or flat-topped block used as the focus for a religious ritual, especially for making sacrifices or offerings to a deity.
<b>chalice</b>	A large cup or goblet.
<b>confessional</b>	Relating to confessions of faith or doctrinal systems. <i>The priest leaned forward in his best <b>confessional</b> manner.</i>
<b>consecrate</b>	Give entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause. <i>The <b>consecrated</b> chapel.</i>
<b><u>consign</u></b>	Commit forever; commit irrevocably. <i><b>Consign</b> your baggage.</i>
<b>dedicate</b>	Open to public use, as of a highway, park, or building. <i>Volume four is <b>dedicated</b> to wasps.</i>
<b>dedicated</b>	Solemnly dedicated to or set apart for a high or sacred purpose. <i>A <b>dedicated</b> dancer.</i>
<b><u>dedication</u></b>	The quality of being dedicated or committed to a task or purpose. <i>A faintly engraved inscription or <b>dedication</b>.</i>
<b><u>devotion</u></b>	Prayers or religious observances. <i>She was the epitome of wifely <b>devotion</b>.</i>
<b><u>give</u></b>	Give as a present make a gift of. <i>I hope I don t <b>give</b> you my cold.</i>
<b>goblet</b>	A drinking glass with a base and stem. <i>A beautifully engraved crystal <b>goblet</b>.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Used in exclamations of surprise or dismay. <i><b>Holy</b> smoke.</i>
<b>lectern</b>	Desk or stand with a slanted top used to hold a text at the proper height for a lecturer.
<b>lecture</b>	Deliver an educational lecture or lectures. <i>He attended a <b>lecture</b> on telecommunications.</i>

<b>loss</b>	Gradual decline in amount or activity. <i>Funding cuts will lead to job <b>losses</b>.</i>
<b>oblation</b>	The presentation of bread and wine to God in the Eucharist. <i><b>Oblations</b> for aid to the poor.</i>
<b>offering</b>	The verbal act of offering. <i>Noteworthy new <b>offerings</b> for investors included several index funds.</i>
<b>orison</b>	Reverent petition to a deity.
<b>podium</b>	Of a competitor in a sporting event finish first second or third so as to appear on a podium to receive an award. <i>I took the score out of my briefcase and put it on the <b>podium</b>.</i>
<b>prayer</b>	A solemn request for help or expression of thanks addressed to God or another deity. <i>I ll say a <b>prayer</b> for him.</i>
<b>propitiatory</b>	Intended to reconcile or appease. <i>Expiatory or <b>propitiatory</b> sacrifice.</i>
<b>pulpit</b>	Religious teaching as expressed in sermons. <i>The movies could rival the <b>pulpit</b> as an agency moulding the ideas of the mass public.</i>
<b>religion</b>	The belief in and worship of a superhuman controlling power, especially a personal God or gods. <i>The world s great <b>religions</b>.</i>
<b>reliquary</b>	A container where religious relics are stored or displayed (especially relics of saints).
<b>requiem</b>	A musical composition setting parts of a requiem Mass or of a similar character. <i>A <b>requiem</b> was held for the dead queen.</i>
<b>sacrificial</b>	Designed to be used up or destroyed in fulfilling a purpose or function. <i>An altar for <b>sacrificial</b> offerings.</i>
<b>tithe</b>	Pay or give as a tithe. <i>He hadn t said a <b>tithe</b> of the prayers he knew.</i>
<b>votive</b>	Dedicated in fulfillment of a vow. <i><b>Votive</b> offerings.</i>
<b>willing</b>	Disposed or inclined toward. <i><b>Willing</b> helpers.</i>
