Present Tense	<b>salsa / salsas</b>
Past Tense	<b>salsaed</b>
Present Participle	<b>salsaing</b>
Past Participle	<b>salsaed</b>

I <b>salsa</b>	We <b>salsa</b>
You <b>salsa</b>	You <b>salsa</b>
He/She/It <b>salsas</b>	They <b>salsa</b>

## **Salsa in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am salsaing</b>	We <b>are salsaing</b>
You <b>are salsaing</b>	You <b>are salsaing</b>
He/She/It <b>is salsaing</b>	They <b>are salsaing</b>
