- *The quality of wearisome constancy, routine, and lack of variety.*
- *The quality of being the same; identity or similarity.*



Synonyms of "Sameness" as a noun (24 Words)

alikeness	The quality or fact of being alike; resemblance, similarity.
<u>closeness</u>	The quality of affection or intimacy in a relationship. <i>The closeness with which he watched current events.</i>
comparability	Qualities that are comparable. <i>There are differences in hospital recording practices that will affect the comparability of results.</i>
congruence	Agreement or harmony; compatibility. <i>The results show quite good congruence with recent studies.</i>
congruity	The quality of agreeing; being suitable and appropriate.
<u>consistency</u>	The quality of achieving a level of performance which does not vary greatly in quality over time. <i>We know we have the ability at the club what we need is consistency.</i>

<u>correspondence</u>	An attribute of a shape or relation; exact reflection of form on opposite sides of a dividing line or plane. <i>The organization engaged in detailed correspondence with local MPs.</i>
equality	A symbolic expression of the fact that two quantities are equal; an equation. <i>An organization aiming to promote racial equality.</i>
equivalence	The condition of being equal or equivalent in value, worth, function, etc. <i>Precise equivalences between qualifications across Europe.</i>
humdrum	The quality of wearisome constancy, routine, and lack of variety. <i>He was sick of the humdrum of his fellow prisoners.</i>
identicalness	The quality of being identical; sameness; identity.
identity	An element of a set which, if combined with another element by a specified binary operation, leaves that element unchanged. <i>She guessed the identity of his lover.</i>
indistinguishability	Exact sameness.
interchangeability	The quality of being capable of exchange or interchange.
likeness	The semblance, guise, or outward appearance of. <i>Her likeness to him was astonishing.</i>
<u>monotony</u>	Constancy of tone or pitch or inflection. <i>Depression flattens the voice almost to monotony.</i>
oneness	The quality of being united into one. <i>A strong sense of oneness is felt with all things.</i>
parallelism	The use of successive verbal constructions in poetry or prose which correspond in grammatical structure, sound, metre, meaning, etc. <i>The parallelisms are reinforced by frequent alliteration.</i>
parity	Computer science a bit that is used in an error detection procedure in which a 0 or 1 is added to each group of bits so that it will have either an odd number of 1 s or an even number of 1 s e g if the parity is odd then any group of bits that arrives with an even number of 1 s must contain an error. <i>The parity of the mother must be considered.</i>
<u>resemblance</u>	A way in which two or more things are alike. <i>They bear some resemblance to Italian figurines.</i>
selfsameness	The quality of being identical with itself.
similarity	A similar feature or aspect. <i>The similarity of symptoms makes them hard to diagnose.</i>

similitude

The quality or state of being similar to something.
*Conrad uses a range of constructions which express or imply **similitude**.*

uniformity

A condition in which everything is regular and unvarying.
*An attempt to impose administrative and cultural **uniformity**.*



Usage Examples of "Sameness" as a noun

- *He hated the sameness of the food the college served.*
- *There is a sameness about all the political parties.*
- *Sameness of meaning across different languages.*
