balance	A weight that balances another weight. <i>He accumulated a healthy balance with the savings bank.</i>
balance of mind	A state of equilibrium.
common sense	A piece of open land for recreational use in an urban area.
good sense	Moral excellence or admirableness.
judiciousness	The trait of forming opinions by distinguishing and evaluating.
lucidity	Brightness; luminosity. <i>His lecture combined intellectual lucidity and passion.</i>

lucidness	Free from obscurity and easy to understand; the comprehensibility of clear expression.
normality	Something regarded as a normative example. <i>The office gradually returned to a semblance of normality.</i>
practicality	The aspects of a situation that involve the actual doing or experience of something rather than theories or ideas. <i>There are still major doubts about the practicality of the proposal.</i>
prudence	Knowing how to avoid embarrassment or distress. <i>We need to exercise prudence in such important matters.</i>
rationality	The quality of being based on or in accordance with reason or logic. <i>Like any phobia rationality plays only a small role.</i>
reason	What is right, practical, or possible; common sense. <i>I resigned for personal reasons.</i>
reasonableness	Goodness of reason and judgment. <i>Without greater reasonableness by both parties we will never settle this matter.</i>
saneness	Normal or sound powers of mind.
sense	Relating to or denoting a coding sequence of nucleotides complementary to an antisense sequence. <i>A sense of happiness.</i>
senses	A natural appreciation or ability. <i>In the dark he had to depend on touch and on his senses of smell and hearing.</i>
sensibleness	The quality of showing good sense or practical judgment.
soundness	The quality of being prudent and sensible. <i>You really have to question the soundness of these measures.</i>
soundness of mind	The muscle tone of healthy tissue.
stability	The quality or attribute of being firm and steadfast. <i>There are fears for the political stability of the area.</i>
wisdom	An Apocryphal book consisting mainly of a meditation on wisdom although ascribed to Solomon it was probably written in the first century BC. <i>Eastern wisdom.</i>
wits	The basic human power of intelligent thought and perception. <i>I was scared out of my wits.</i>
