<b>angularity</b>	A shape having one or more sharp angles.

<b>centered</b>	Being or placed in the center.
<b>central</b>	A workplace that serves as a telecommunications facility where lines from telephones can be connected together to permit communication. <i><b>Central</b> government.</i>
<b>concentric</b>	Having a common center. <i><b>Concentric</b> rings.</i>
<b>disproof</b>	The action of proving that something is untrue. <i>The answer ought to turn on considerations that are susceptible to verification or <b>disproof</b>.</i>
<b>dot</b>	Make a dot or dots. <i>You need to <b>dot</b> the i.</i>
<b>emphatically</b>	In a forceful way. <i>Jane though born in California feels <b>emphatically</b> English.</i>
<b>focal</b>	Relating to the centre or most important part. <i><b>Focal</b> infection.</i>
<b>fulcrum</b>	The pivot about which a lever turns. <i>Research is the <b>fulcrum</b> of the academic community.</i>
<b>homocentric</b>	Having the same centre.

<b>jag</b>	Cut teeth into make a jagged cutting edge. <i>He clutched a <b>jag</b> of the rock.</i>
<b>keynote</b>	Set the keynote of. <i>Comfort <b>keynotes</b> this designer s Fall collection.</i>
<b>mote</b>	(nontechnical usage) a tiny piece of anything. <i>The tiniest <b>mote</b> of dust.</i>
<b>mottle</b>	A spot or patch forming part of a mottled arrangement. <i>The ship was not dull grey as distance had suggested but a <b>mottle</b> of khaki and black and olive green.</i>
<b><u>pivot</u></b>	The act of turning on or as if on a pivot. <i>The <b>pivot</b> of community life was the chapel.</i>
<b><u>pivotal</u></b>	Being of crucial importance- Henry Kissinger. <i>Japan s <b>pivotal</b> role in the world economy.</i>
<b>prospect</b>	A prediction of the course of a disease. <i>There was no <b>prospect</b> of a reconciliation.</i>
<b>refutation</b>	The action of proving a statement or theory to be wrong or false. <i>He fails to give a clear <b>refutation</b> of the argument.</i>
<b>soupcon</b>	A slight but appreciable amount.
<b>speck</b>	Produce specks in or on. <i>The figure in the distance had become a mere <b>speck</b>.</i>
<b>plotch</b>	A blob or smear of something, typically a liquid. <i>A <b>plotch</b> of red in a larger area of yellow.</i>
<b><u>spot</u></b>	Make a spot or mark onto. <i>The higher rated team <b>spots</b> the lower rated team the difference in their handicaps.</i>
<b>stain</b>	Produce or leave stains. <i>People knew how to <b>stain</b> glass a beautiful blue in the middle ages.</i>
<b><u>standpoint</u></b>	A mental position from which things are viewed. <i>She writes on religion from the <b>standpoint</b> of a believer.</i>
<b><u>streak</u></b>	Cover a surface with streaks. <i>A <b>streak</b> for charity.</i>
<b><u>stud</u></b>	The height of a room as indicated by the length of a timber wall stud. <i>Diamond <b>stud</b> earrings.</i>
<b>vertex</b>	The highest point; the top or apex.
