Scam in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am scamming We are scamming
You are scamming You are scamming
He/She/It is scamming They are scamming

Scam in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have scammed We have scammed You have scammed You have scammed He/She/It has scammed They have scammed

Scam in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been scamming
You have been scamming
He/She/It has been scamming
They have been scamming

Scam in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI scammedWe scammedYou scammedYou scammedHe/She/It scammedThey scammed

Scam in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was scamming We were scamming
You were scamming
He/She/It was scamming They were scamming

Scam in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had scammed
You had scammed
He/She/It had scammed They had scammed

Scam in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been scamming
You had been scamming
You had been scamming
He/She/It had been scamming They had been scamming

Scam in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI will scamWe will scamYou will scamYou will scamHe/She/It will scamThey will scam

Scam in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be scamming
You will be scamming
He/She/It will be scamming
They will be scamming

Scam in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have scammed
You will have scammed
You will have scammed
He/She/It will have scammed
They will have scammed

Scam in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been scamming
You will have been scamming
He/She/It will have been scamming
They will have been scamming
