Definitions of "Schema" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “schema” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A syllogistic figure.*
- *An internal representation of the world; an organization of concepts and actions that can be revised by new information about the world.*
- *(in Kantian philosophy) a conception of what is common to all members of a class; a general or essential type or form.*
- *A schematic or preliminary plan.*
- *A representation of a plan or theory in the form of an outline or model.*



Synonyms of "Schema" as a noun (15 Words)

- arrangement** A plan or preparation for a future event.
*Mozart's symphonies in **arrangements** for cello and piano.*
- configuration** Any spatial attributes (especially as defined by outline).
*The unrepeatable **configuration** of the stars at the moment of your birth.*
- disposition** The action of arranging people or things in a particular way.
*If Napoleon had had railways at his **disposition** he would have been invincible.*
- format** The organization of information according to preset specifications usually for computer processing.
*The **format** is A4 on newsprint.*
- framework** A hypothetical description of a complex entity or process.
*Providing a factual **framework** for future research.*
- layout** The act of laying out (as by making plans for something).
*Doing **layout** for newspapers and magazines.*

organization	An organized structure for arranging or classifying. <i>He was brought in to supervise the organization of a new department.</i>
outline	The contours or bounds of an object. <i>The outlines of dockside warehouses standing sharp on the skyline.</i>
pattern	A wooden or metal model from which a mould is made for a casting. <i>A neat blue herringbone pattern.</i>
plan	A drawing or diagram made by projection on a horizontal plane especially one showing the layout of a building or one floor of a building. <i>Look at the seating plan.</i>
plot	A small piece of ground marked out for a purpose such as building or gardening. <i>A vegetable plot.</i>
scheme	An internal representation of the world; an organization of concepts and actions that can be revised by new information about the world. <i>Police uncovered a scheme to steal paintings worth more than 250 000.</i>
storyline	The plot of a book or play or film.
structure	The arrangement of and relations between the parts or elements of something complex. <i>He has good bone structure.</i>
system	A procedure or process for obtaining an objective. <i>Exercise helped him get the alcohol out of his system.</i>
