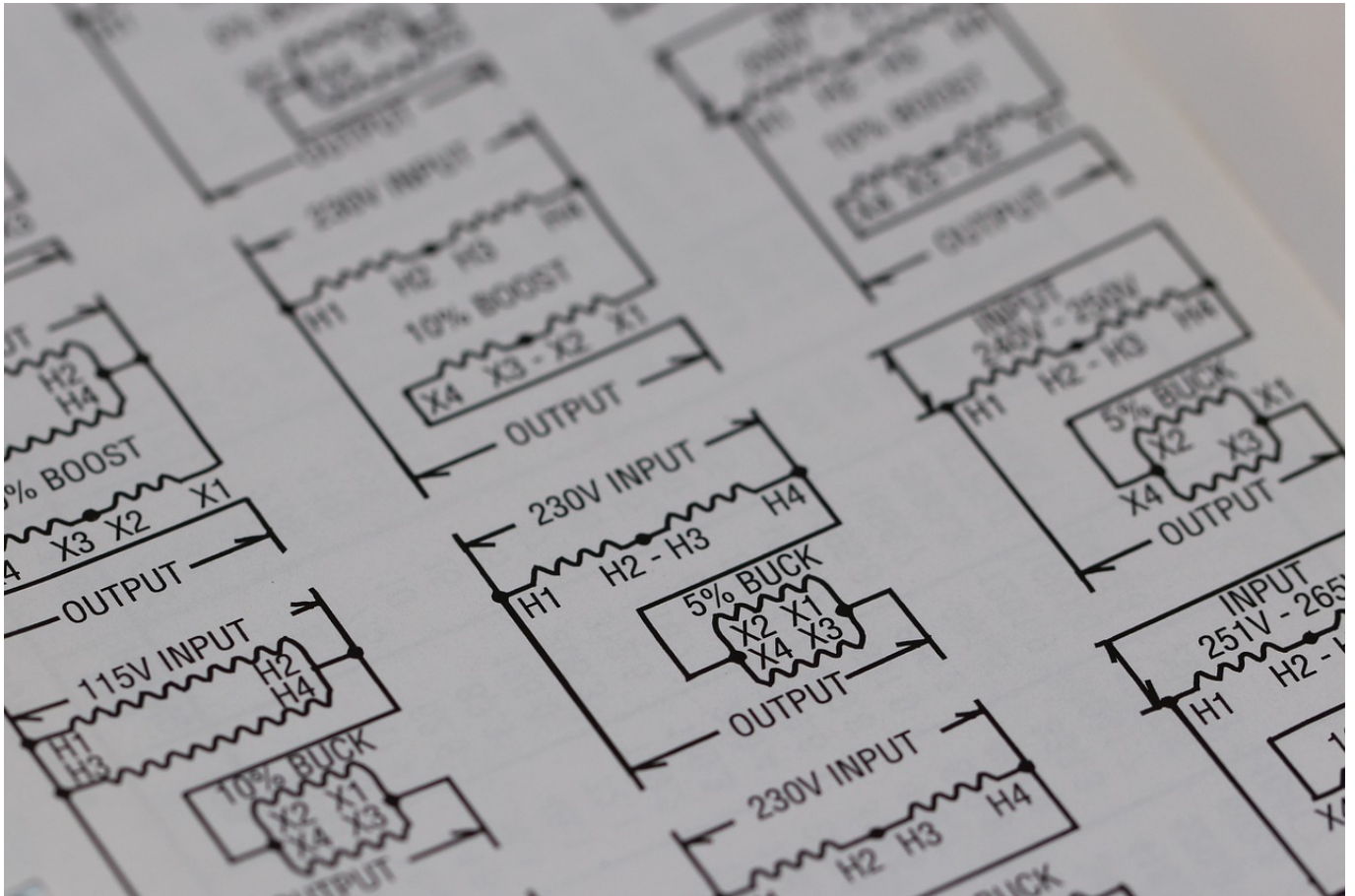

## Synonyms of "Schematic" as a noun (1 Word)

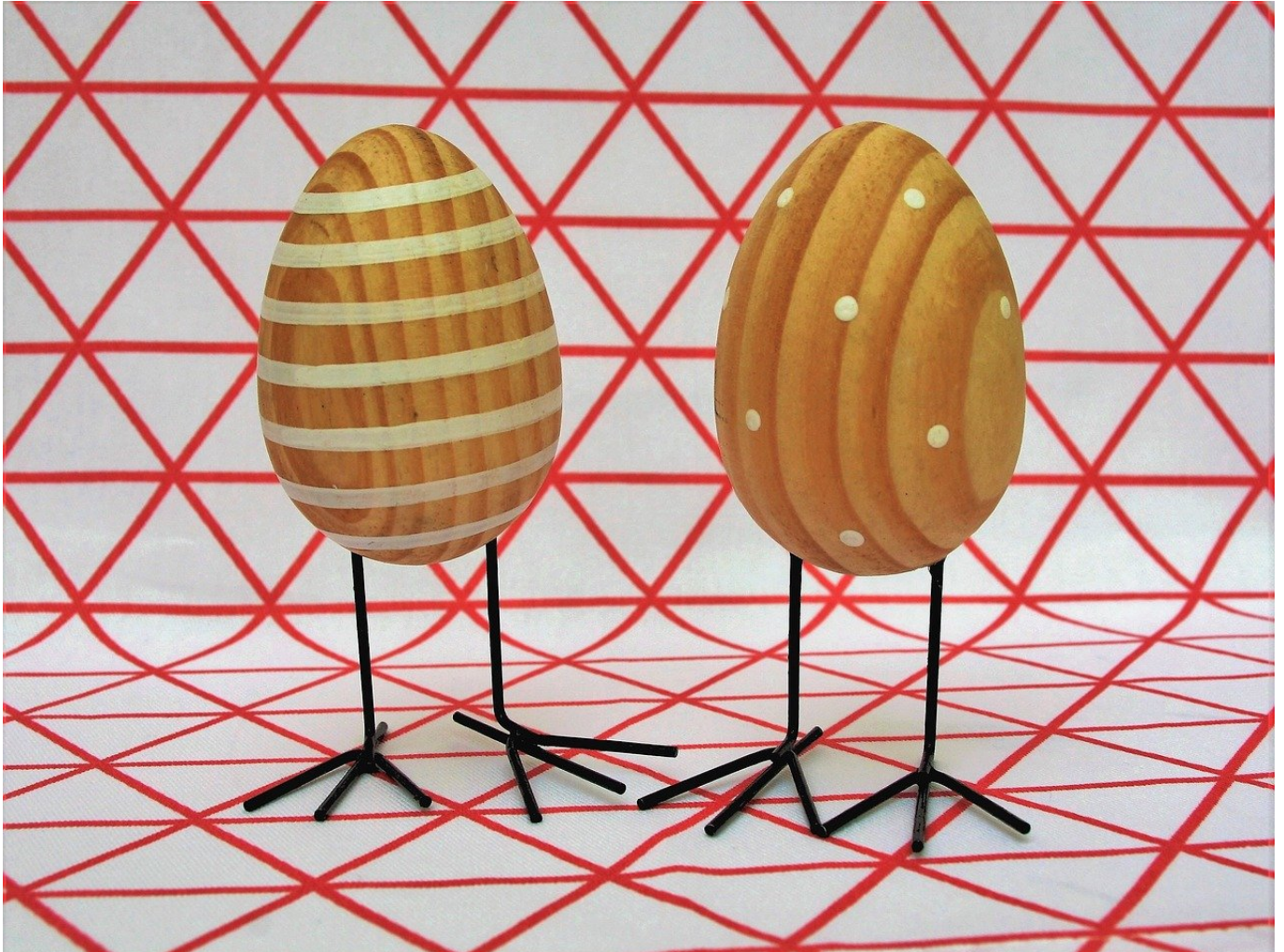
**schematic drawing** Diagram of an electrical or mechanical system.

## Schematic as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Schematic" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "schematic" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Represented in simplified or symbolic form.*
- *(of a diagram or other representation) symbolic and simplified.*
- *(of thought, ideas, etc.) simplistic or formulaic in character.*





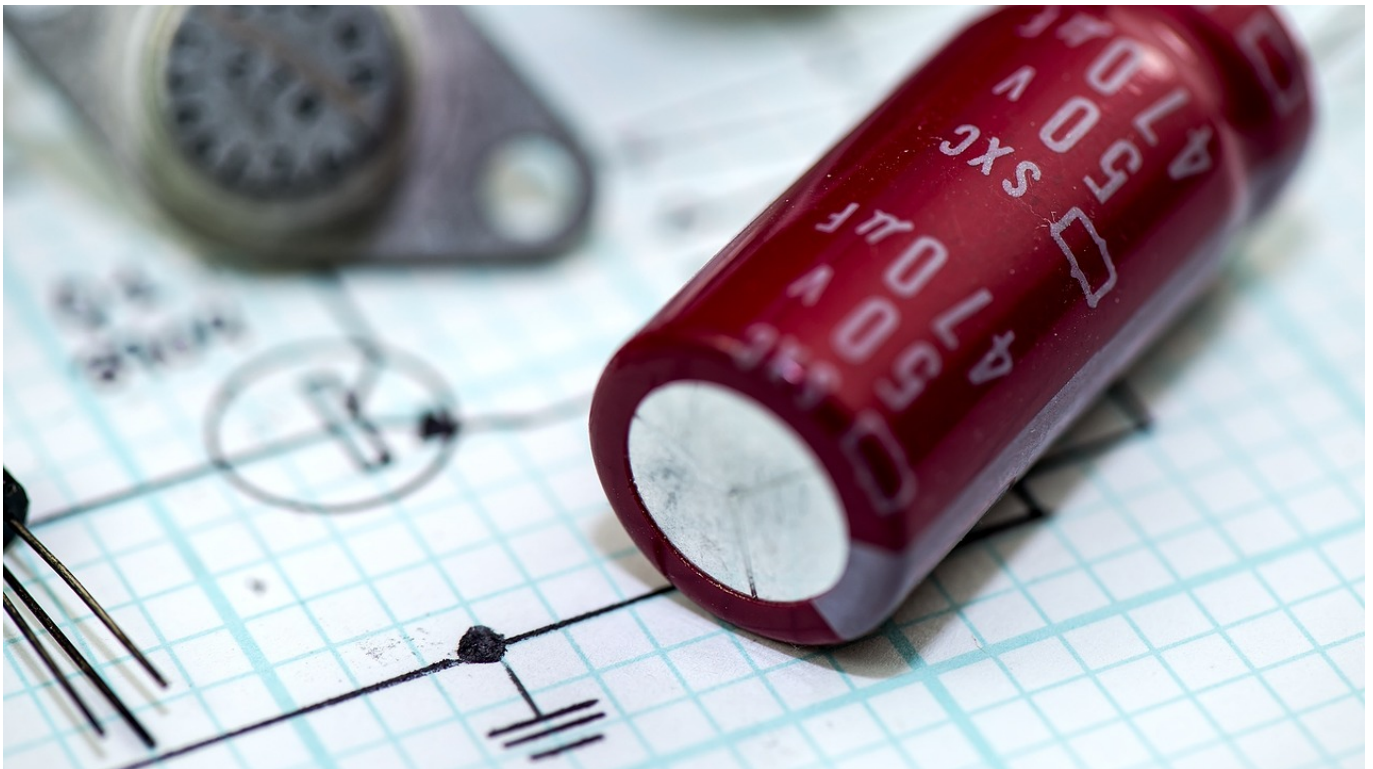
## Synonyms of "Schematic" as an adjective (7 Words)

- conventional** (of a bid) intended to convey a particular meaning according to an agreed convention.  
*West made a **conventional** bid showing a hand with at least 5 spades.*
- formal** Being in accord with established forms and conventions and requirements as e.g. of formal dress.  
*A **formal** dinner party.*
- formulaic** Constituting or containing a set form of words.  
***Formulaic** disposable pop.*
- oversimple** Lacking sophistication and subtlety.  
*An **oversimple** theory of human nature.*

**oversimplified** Simplified to such an extent that a distorted impression is given.  
*An **oversimplified** view of human personality.*

**simplistic** Treating complex issues and problems as if they were much simpler than they really are.  
*A **simplistic** theory of the universe.*

**unimaginative** Dealing only with concrete facts.  
*He was an **unimaginative** leader.*



## Usage Examples of "Schematic" as an adjective

- *Freeman constructs a highly schematic reading of the play.*
- *This concept is shown in schematic form in Figure 1.*
- *Schematic diagrams.*

## Associations of "Schematic" (30 Words)

**architect** Someone who creates plans to be used in making something (such as buildings).  
*The **architects** of the reform programme.*

<b>artwork</b>	Photographs or other visual representations in a printed publication. <i>The technology can produce finished <b>artwork</b> for anything from press ads to corporate brochures.</i>
<b><u>blueprint</u></b>	Make a blueprint of. <i>The landscape architect <b>blueprinted</b> a ten year plan for regeneration of the magnificent formal gardens.</i>
<b>cartography</b>	The making of maps and charts.
<b><u>chart</u></b>	Plot a course on a chart. <i>The pilot found his craft taking a route he had not <b>charted</b>.</i>
<b>chiaroscuro</b>	An effect of contrasted light and shadow. <i>The <b>chiaroscuro</b> of cobbled streets.</i>
<b>crayon</b>	Draw with a crayon or crayons. <i>A child <b>crayoning</b> in a colouring book.</i>
<b><u>diagram</u></b>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>A <b>diagram</b> of the living room.</i>
<b>draft</b>	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>He took a sleeping <b>draft</b>.</i>
<b>draftsmanship</b>	The creation of artistic pictures or diagrams.
<b><u>drawing</u></b>	The art or activity of making drawings. <i><b>Drawings</b> of abstract forms.</i>
<b>exploded</b>	(of a diagram) showing the components of a mechanism in the normal relative positions but slightly separated from each other. <i>Teams are analysing fragments from the two <b>exploded</b> bombs.</i>
<b>flowchart</b>	A diagram of the sequence of operations in a computer program or an accounting system.
<b>graffiti</b>	Write or draw graffiti on something. <i>He <b>graffitied</b> his tag on a window and door.</i>
<b><u>graph</u></b>	Plot upon a graph.
<b><u>graphic</u></b>	Of or relating to the graphic arts British Book News. <i>A <b>graphic</b> account of the riots.</i>
<b><u>imagery</u></b>	Visual images collectively. <i>The film s religious <b>imagery</b>.</i>
<b>machination</b>	A plot or scheme.
<b><u>maneuver</u></b>	A military training exercise. <i>She <b>maneuvered</b> herself into the directorship.</i>
<b>map</b>	Depict as if on a map. <i><b>Map</b> the genes.</i>



<b>mimesis</b>	The deliberate imitation of the behaviour of one group of people by another group as a factor in social change. <i>Barth has always detached his use of plot from <b>mimesis</b>.</i>
<b>mimetic</b>	Exhibiting mimicry. <i>The <b>mimetic</b> tendency of infancy.</i>
<b>painting</b>	The occupation of a house painter. <i>An oil <b>painting</b>.</i>
<b>picture</b>	Represent in a photograph or picture. <i>The author gives a depressing <b>picture</b> of life in Poland.</i>
<b>plat</b>	Make a plat of. <i>He bought back the site <b>platted</b> it and named it after his realtor.</i>
<b>plot</b>	The main events of a play, novel, film, or similar work, devised and presented by the writer as an interrelated sequence. <i>The dependent variable <b>s</b> points are <b>plotted</b> on the Y axis.</i>
<b>representation</b>	A statement or allegation. <i>A striking <b>representation</b> of a vase of flowers.</i>
<b>smoothed</b>	Made smooth by ironing.
<b>strategically</b>	In a way that relates to the achievement of long-term or overall aims and interests. <i><b>Strategically</b> important ports.</i>
<b>technicolor</b>	A trademarked method of making color motion pictures.
