Infinitive	<b>to sclerotise</b>
Present Tense	<b>sclerotise / sclerotises</b>
Past Tense	<b>sclerotised</b>
Present Participle	<b>sclerotising</b>
Past Participle	<b>sclerotised</b>

## Conjugate Sclerotise

**Sclerotise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>sclerotise</b>	We <b>sclerotise</b>
You <b>sclerotise</b>	You <b>sclerotise</b>
He/She/It <b>sclerotises</b>	They <b>sclerotise</b>

**Sclerotise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am sclerotising</b>	We <b>are sclerotising</b>
You <b>are sclerotising</b>	You <b>are sclerotising</b>
He/She/It <b>is sclerotising</b>	They <b>are sclerotising</b>

**Sclerotise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have sclerotised</b>	We <b>have sclerotised</b>
You <b>have sclerotised</b>	You <b>have sclerotised</b>
He/She/It <b>has sclerotised</b>	They <b>have sclerotised</b>

I <b>have been sclerotising</b>	We <b>have been sclerotising</b>
You <b>have been sclerotising</b>	You <b>have been sclerotising</b>
He/She/It <b>has been sclerotising</b>	They <b>have been sclerotising</b>

<b>I had sclerotised</b>	<b>We had sclerotised</b>
<b>You had sclerotised</b>	<b>You had sclerotised</b>
<b>He/She/It had sclerotised</b>	<b>They had sclerotised</b>

<b>I had been sclerotising</b>	<b>We had been sclerotising</b>
<b>You had been sclerotising</b>	<b>You had been sclerotising</b>
<b>He/She/It had been sclerotising</b>	<b>They had been sclerotising</b>
