Singular

Plural

I **seajack** We **seajack**
You **seajack** You **seajack**
He/She/It **seajacks** They **seajack**

Seajack in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am seajacking** We **are seajacking**
You **are seajacking** You **are seajacking**
He/She/It **is seajacking** They **are seajacking**

Seajack in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have seajacked** We **have seajacked**
You **have seajacked** You **have seajacked**
He/She/It **has seajacked** They **have seajacked**

Seajack in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I **have been seajacking** We **have been seajacking**
You **have been seajacking** You **have been seajacking**
He/She/It **has been seajacking** They **have been seajacking**

Seajack in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was seajacking We were seajacking
You were seajacking You were seajacking
He/She/It was seajacking They were seajacking

Seajack in Past Perfect Tense

I had seajacked We had seajacked
You had seajacked You had seajacked
He/She/It had seajacked They had seajacked

Seajack in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been seajacking We had been seajacking
You had been seajacking You had been seajacking
He/She/It had been seajacking They had been seajacking

Seajack in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will seajack We will seajack
You will seajack You will seajack
He/She/It will seajack They will seajack

Seajack in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be seajacking We will be seajacking
You will be seajacking You will be seajacking
He/She/It will be seajacking They will be seajacking

Seajack in Future Perfect Tense

I will have seajacked

We will have seajacked

You will have seajacked

You will have seajacked

He/She/It will have seajacked

They will have seajacked

We will have been seajacking

You will have been seajacking
