Sean in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am seaning We are seaning
You are seaning You are seaning
He/She/It is seaning They are seaning

Sean in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I have seaned We have seaned
You have seaned You have seaned
He/She/It has seaned They have seaned

Sean in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been seaning We have been seaning

You have been seaning You have been seaning

He/She/It has been seaning They have been seaning

Sean in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Sean in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was seaning We were seaning
You were seaning You were seaning
He/She/It was seaning They were seaning

Sean in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **had seaned** We **had seaned**You **had seaned** You **had seaned**He/She/It **had seaned** They **had seaned**

Sean in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been seaning
You had been seaning
He/She/It had been seaning
They had been seaning

Sean in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will sean We will sean
You will sean You will sean
He/She/It will sean They will sean

Sean in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be seaning
You will be seaning
He/She/It will be seaning
They will be seaning

Sean in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have seaned
You will have seaned
He/She/It will have seaned
They will have seaned

Sean in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been seaning
You will have been seaning
He/She/It will have been seaning
They will have been seaning
