# **Conjugate Sear**

### Sear in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>sear</b>	We <b>sear</b>
You <b>sear</b>	You <b>sear</b>
He/She/It <b>sears</b>	They <b>sear</b>

### Sear in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am searing	We are searing
You <b>are searing</b>	You <b>are searing</b>
He/She/It is searing	They are searing

#### **Sear in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have seared	We have seared
You have seared	You have seared
He/She/It has seared	They have seared

### **Sear in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been searing	We have been searing
You <b>have been searing</b>	You have been searing
He/She/It has been searing	They have been searing

### Sear in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I seared	We <b>seared</b>
You <b>seared</b>	You <b>seared</b>
He/She/It <b>seared</b>	They $\boldsymbol{seared}$

### Sear in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was searing	We were searing
You <b>were searing</b>	You <b>were searing</b>
He/She/It was searing	They were searing

#### **Sear in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had seared	We had seared
You had seared	You <b>had seared</b>
He/She/It had seared	They had seared

### Sear in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been searing	We had been searing
You <b>had been searing</b>	You had been searing
He/She/It had been searing	They had been searing

### Sear in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will sear</b>	We <b>will sear</b>
You <b>will sear</b>	You <b>will sear</b>
He/She/It will sear	They will sear

### Sear in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be searing	We will be searing
You <b>will be searing</b>	You <b>will be searing</b>
He/She/It will be searing	They will be searing

#### Sear in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been searing	We <b>will have been searing</b>
You <b>will have been searing</b>	You <b>will have been searing</b>
He/She/It will have been searing	They will have been searing
