Associations of "Second fiddle" (30 Words)

commandment	A rule to be observed as strictly as one of the Ten Commandments. <i>She had followed her mother's commandments for long enough.</i>
double	A double measure of spirits. <i>The dose is doubled.</i>
<u>dual</u>	A theorem expression etc that is dual to another. <i>A dual flight.</i>
eighth	Coming next after the seventh and just before the ninth in position.
eleventh	Coming next after the tenth and just before the twelfth in position.
fifth	A quantity of liquor equal to one fifth of a United States gallon. <i>He was fifth out of several hundred runners.</i>
first	The first or highest in an ordering or series. <i>First we must consider the garter snake.</i>
five	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
four	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
fourth	In the fourth place. <i>Fourthly you must pay the rent on the first of the month.</i>
geometer	A mathematician specializing in geometry.
homer	United States painter best known for his seascapes (1836-1910). <i>He homered for the sixth time in seven games.</i>
inning	One of nine divisions of play during which each team has a turn at bat.
ninth	Coming next after the eighth and just before the tenth in position. <i>Going into the ninth they were a run ahead.</i>
<u>number</u>	Determine the number or amount of. <i>Think of a number from one to ten and multiply it by three.</i>
ordinal	Relating to an ordinal number. <i>Ordinal scales.</i>

quadruple	A quadruple number or amount. <i>Quadruple rhythm has four beats per measure.</i>
quartet	A composition for a quartet. <i>A quartet of comfortable armchairs.</i>
sextuple	Consisting of six parts or things.
six	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows six pips.
sixth	One part in six equal parts.
<u>subjugation</u>	The action of bringing someone or something under domination or control. <i>The colonial subjugation of a country by means of brute military force.</i>
teaching	The profession of a teacher. <i>I went into teaching because I like working with children.</i>
tenth	A tenth part one part in ten equal parts.
ternary	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one. <i>A ternary operation.</i>
third	The base that must be touched third by a base runner in baseball. <i>He is playing third.</i>
thirty	Being ten more than twenty.
<u>times</u>	An arithmetic operation that is the inverse of division; the product of two numbers is computed. <i>It was a sign of the times.</i>
<u>triple</u>	Hit a triple. <i>The party more than tripled its share of the vote.</i>
twice	Two times; on two occasions. <i>I m twice your age.</i>
