<a href="#">backdrop</a>	Scenery hung at back of stage. <i>The rolling hills that <b>backdropped</b> our camp.</i>
<a href="#">background</a>	Form a background to. <i>The embassy filled him in on the <b>background</b> of the incident.</i>
<b>circumstance</b>	The set of facts or circumstances that surround a situation or event. <i>We wanted to marry but <b>circumstances</b> didn't permit.</i>
<b>circumstances</b>	Your overall circumstances or condition in life including everything that happens to you. <i>He found himself in straitened <b>circumstances</b>.</i>
<b>condition</b>	Apply a conditioner to the hair. <i>She was in a serious <b>condition</b>.</i>
<b>context</b>	The parts of something written or spoken that immediately precede and follow a word or passage and clarify its meaning. <i>The historical <b>context</b>.</i>
<a href="#">contextual</a>	Depending on the preceding or following parts of a text to clarify meaning. <i>They have limited practice in working out the meaning of unfamiliar material from <b>contextual</b> clues.</i>
<b>diorama</b>	A miniature film set used for special effects or animation.
<a href="#">elemental</a>	Related to or embodying the powers of nature. <i>Gods and <b>elementals</b> looked out upon the worshippers.</i>
<b>environment</b>	The setting or conditions in which a particular activity is carried on. <i>A parliamentary <b>environment</b> committee.</i>
<b>environmental</b>	Relating to or arising from a person's surroundings. <i><b>Environmental</b> noise.</i>
<b>equivocally</b>	In an ambiguous manner.
<a href="#">landscape</a>	Do landscape gardening. <i>We changed the <b>landscape</b> for solving the problem of payroll inequity.</i>

<b>liquefaction</b>	The process of making something, especially a gas, liquid. <i>A gas <b>liquefaction</b> plant.</i>
<b>locale</b>	The scene of any event or action (especially the place of a meeting). <i>Her summers were spent in a variety of exotic <b>locales</b>.</i>
<b>milieu</b>	The environmental condition. <i>Gregory came from the same aristocratic <b>milieu</b> as Sidonius.</i>
<b>palimpsest</b>	A manuscript (usually written on papyrus or parchment) on which more than one text has been written with the earlier writing incompletely erased and still visible. <i>Sutton Place is a <b>palimpsest</b> of the taste of successive owners.</i>
<b>panorama</b>	The visual percept of a region. <i>The tower offers a wonderful <b>panorama</b> of Prague.</i>
<b>prerequisite</b>	Required as a prior condition. <i>The student must have the <b>prerequisite</b> skills.</i>
<b>readjust</b>	Adjust anew. <i>I <b>readjusted</b> the rear view mirror.</i>
<b>scene</b>	The pieces of scenery used in a play or opera. <i>The police returned to the <b>scene</b> of the crime.</i>
<b>scenery</b>	The painted background used to represent natural features or other surroundings on a theatre stage or film set. <i>They worked all night painting the <b>scenery</b>.</i>
<b>setting</b>	A piece of vocal or choral music composed for particular words. <i>A garnet in a heavy gold <b>setting</b>.</i>
<b>surrounding</b>	Closely encircling. <i>Cardiff and the <b>surrounding</b> area.</i>
<b>surroundings</b>	The environmental condition. <i>I took up the time admiring my <b>surroundings</b>.</i>
<b>tenth</b>	A tenth part one part in ten equal parts.
<b>term</b>	Give a descriptive name to call by a specified term. <i>He could only be dealt with on his own <b>terms</b>.</i>
<b>unsanitary</b>	Not sanitary or healthful. <i><b>Unsanitary</b> open sewers.</i>
<b>vista</b>	The visual percept of a region. <i>Sweeping lawns and landscaped <b>vistas</b>.</i>
<b>workplace</b>	A place where work is done. <i><b>Workplace</b> nurseries.</i>
