I am seconding
You are seconding
He/She/It is seconding They are seconding

Second in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have seconded We have seconded You have seconded You have seconded He/She/It has seconded They have seconded

Second in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been seconding
You have been seconding
He/She/It has been seconding
They have been seconding

Second in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Second in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was seconding
You were seconding
He/She/It was seconding They were seconding

Second in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had seconded
You had seconded
He/She/It had seconded
They had seconded

Second in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been seconding
You had been seconding
He/She/It had been seconding
They had been seconding

Second in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will second
You will second
He/She/It will second
They will second

Second in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be seconding
You will be seconding
He/She/It will be seconding
They will be seconding

Second in Future Perfect Tense

I will have seconded
You will have seconded
He/She/It will have seconded
They will have seconded

Second in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been seconding
You will have been seconding
He/She/It will have been seconding
They will have been seconding
