- furthermore** In addition; besides (used to introduce a fresh consideration in an argument).  
*Computer chess games are getting cheaper all the time **furthermore** their quality is improving.*
- moreover** As a further matter; besides.  
*The cellar was dark **moreover** mice nested there.*
- second** In the second place.  
***Second** we must consider the economy.*

<b>absolutely</b>	<i>White collar crime increased both <b>absolutely</b> and in comparison with other categories.</i>
<b>coda</b>	The concluding passage of a piece or movement, typically forming an addition to the basic structure. <i>The first movement ends with a fortissimo <b>coda</b>.</i>
<b>conclusively</b>	In a decisive way that has the effect of proving a case. <i>Wars are difficult to win <b>conclusively</b>.</i>
<b>confront</b>	Be face to face with. <i>You must <b>confront</b> your problems.</i>
<b>eighth</b>	One part in eight equal parts.
<b>end</b>	The person who plays at one end of the line of scrimmage. <i>The man <b>ended</b> by attacking a police officer.</i>
<b>epilogue</b>	A final or concluding act or event. <i>A disastrous <b>epilogue</b> to the rest of his career.</i>
<b>eventually</b>	After an unspecified period of time or an especially long delay. <i><b>Eventually</b> after midnight I arrived at the hotel.</i>
<b>extremity</b>	The greatest or utmost degree. <i>The <b>extremity</b> of despair.</i>
<b>fifth</b>	A quantity of liquor equal to one fifth of a United States gallon. <i>He was <b>fifth</b> out of several hundred runners.</i>
<b>finale</b>	The concluding part of any performance. <i>A fireworks <b>finale</b>.</i>
<b>finally</b>	As the end result of a succession or process. <i>A referendum followed by local legislative and <b>finally</b> presidential elections.</i>
<b>first</b>	The fielding position of the player on a baseball team who is stationed at first of the bases in the infield counting counterclockwise from home plate. <i>His <b>first</b> political race.</i>
<b>five</b>	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
<b>fourth</b>	In the fourth place. <i><b>Fourthly</b> you must pay the rent on the first of the month.</i>
<b>importantly</b>	In an important way. <i>A non drinking non smoking and <b>importantly</b> non political sportsman.</i>

<b>last</b>	The last person or thing the one occurring mentioned or acting after all others. <i>He raised his voice in a <b>last</b> supreme call.</i>
<b>lastly</b>	In the last place (used to introduce the last of a series of points or actions). <i><b>Lastly</b> I would like to thank my parents.</i>
<b>maybe</b>	A mere possibility or probability. <i><b>Maybe</b> I won't go back.</i>
<b>ninth</b>	Coming next after the eighth and just before the tenth in position. <i>Going into the <b>ninth</b> they were a run ahead.</i>
<b>order</b>	The insignia worn by members of an order of honour or merit. <i>The skipper gave the <b>order</b> to abandon ship.</i>
<b>ordinal</b>	Relating to an ordinal number. <i><b>Ordinal</b> numbers.</i>
<b>quadruple</b>	A quadruple number or amount. <i>His stock earning <b>quadrupled</b>.</i>
<b>second</b>	The fielding position of the player on a baseball team who is stationed near the second of the bases in the infield. <i>Do I hear a <b>second</b>.</i>
<b>seventh</b>	Position seven in a countable series of things.
<b>sixth</b>	The musical interval between one note and another six notes away from it.
<b>tenth</b>	A tenth part one part in ten equal parts.
<b>tertiary</b>	The Tertiary period or the system of rocks deposited during it. <i>Patients in <b>tertiary</b> care.</i>
<b>third</b>	The third from the lowest forward ratio gear in the gear box of a motor vehicle. <i>It contains approximately a <b>third</b> of the minimum daily requirement.</i>
<b>ultimately</b>	At the most basic level. <i><b>Ultimately</b> he has only himself to blame.</i>
