### Definitions of "Sector" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “sector” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A distinct part or branch of a nation's economy or society or of a sphere of activity such as education.*
- *The plane figure enclosed by two radii of a circle or ellipse and the arc between them.*
- *A plane figure bounded by two radii and the included arc of a circle.*
- *A subdivision of an area for military operations.*
- *Measuring instrument consisting of two graduated arms hinged at one end.*
- *A mathematical instrument consisting of two arms hinged at one end and marked with sines, tangents, etc. for making diagrams.*
- *A social group that forms part of the society or the economy.*
- *The minimum track length that can be assigned to store information; unless otherwise specified a sector of data consists of 512 bytes.*
- *A subdivision of a track on a magnetic disk.*
- *A portion of a military position.*
- *An area or portion that is distinct from others.*
- *A particular aspect of life or activity.*

<b>area</b>	A part of a structure having some specific characteristic or function. <i><b>Areas</b> of the body.</i>
<b><u>arm</u></b>	A side part of a chair or other seat on which a sitter can rest their arm. <i>An <b>arm</b> of the sea.</i>
<b>borough</b>	(in Alaska) a district corresponding to a county elsewhere in the US.
<b><u>branch</u></b>	A part of a forked or branching shape. <i>A <b>branch</b> of the Clinton River.</i>
<b>category</b>	A collection of things sharing a common attribute. <i>The various <b>categories</b> of research.</i>
<b><u>corner</u></b>	Solid exterior angle of a building especially one formed by a cornerstone. <i>Fountains are discovered in quiet <b>corners</b> and sleepy squares.</i>
<b>department</b>	A specified aspect or quality. <i>You ll find it in the hardware <b>department</b>.</i>

<b><u>district</u></b>	A region defined for an administrative purpose. <i>An elegant shopping <b>district</b>.</i>
<b>division</b>	A group of organisms forming a subdivision of a larger category. <i>The villagers lived in a communal building and there were no solid <b>divisions</b> between neighbours.</i>
<b><u>field</u></b>	Fielders collectively or the manner in which they are spread over the pitch. <i>The variation in the strength of the <b>field</b>.</i>
<b><u>layer</u></b>	A shoot fastened down to take root while attached to the parent plant. <i>The majority of fish are egg <b>layers</b>.</i>
<b>locality</b>	A surrounding or nearby region. <i>The rock s size and <b>locality</b>.</i>
<b>neighbourhood</b>	The area surrounding a particular place, person, or object. <i>She lived in a wealthy <b>neighbourhood</b> of Boston.</i>
<b>part</b>	The part played by a person in bringing about a result. <i>Those of you who jet off to foreign <b>parts</b> for your holidays.</i>
<b>precinct</b>	The police station situated in a precinct. <i>At the <b>precinct</b> a desk sergeant ran through her ID.</i>
<b>quarter</b>	A square charge which covers the top left dexter chief quarter of the field. <i>It s a <b>quarter</b> til 4.</i>
<b><u>section</u></b>	A representation of the internal structure of something as if it has been cut through vertically or horizontally. <i>This last <b>section</b> of the questionnaire relates solely to training.</i>
<b><u>side</u></b>	A television channel considered as one of two or more that are available. <i>The house was built on the <b>side</b> of a mountain.</i>
<b>sphere</b>	The apparent surface of the imaginary sphere on which celestial bodies appear to be projected. <i>His social <b>sphere</b> is limited.</i>
<b>stratum</b>	An abstract place usually conceived as having depth. <i>A <b>stratum</b> of flint.</i>
<b>subdivision</b>	A self-contained part of a larger composition (written or musical). <i>The <b>subdivision</b> of existing subjects.</i>
<b>zone</b>	A belt or girdle worn round a person's body. <i>United are still in the relegation <b>zone</b>.</i>

## Associations of "Sector" (30 Words)

<b>banking</b>	Transacting business with a bank; depositing or withdrawing funds or requesting a loan etc. <i>With this account you are entitled to free <b>banking</b>.</i>
<b>biased</b>	Unfairly prejudiced for or against someone or something. <i>We will not tolerate this <b>biased</b> media coverage.</i>
<u><b>branch</b></u>	Of a tree or plant bear or send out branches. <i>Follow this track south until it <b>branches</b> into two.</i>
<b>department</b>	A specified aspect or quality. <i>Baking is not my <b>department</b>.</i>
<b>fractional</b>	Relating to or expressed as a fraction, especially a fraction less than one. <i><b>Fractional</b> crystallization.</i>
<b>fragmentary</b>	Consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts. <i><b>Fragmentary</b> remains.</i>
<u><b>half</b></u>	A half price fare or ticket especially for a child. <i>The northern <b>half</b> of the island.</i>
<u><b>incomplete</b></u>	Not having all the necessary or appropriate parts. <i><b>Incomplete</b> carvings of cattle.</i>
<b>intersect</b>	Divide (something) by passing or lying across it. <i>The area is <b>intersected</b> only by minor roads.</i>
<b>least</b>	Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>He had a knack for showing up when he was <b>least</b> expected.</i>
<b>offshoot</b>	A thing that develops from something else. <i>Commercial <b>offshoots</b> of universities.</i>
<b>overtone</b>	A musical tone which is a part of the harmonic series above a fundamental note, and may be heard with it. <i><b>Overtones</b> of despair.</i>
<b>part</b>	The appropriate or expected behaviour in a particular role or situation one's duty. <i>Hold the furthest <b>part</b> of your leg that you can reach.</i>
<u><b>partial</b></u>	A harmonic with a frequency that is a multiple of the fundamental frequency. <i><b>Partial</b> collapse.</i>
<u><b>partially</b></u>	To some extent; in some degree; not wholly. <i>The work <b>partially</b> fulfills the function of a historical memoir.</i>
<b>partly</b>	To some extent; not completely. <i>You re only <b>partly</b> right.</i>

<b><u>portion</u></b>	Money or property brought by a woman to her husband at marriage. <i>One end of the barn was <b>portioned</b> off for poultry.</i>
<b>quarter</b>	Cut a log into quarters and these into planks so as to show the grain well. <i>The riot squad gave no <b>quarter</b>.</i>
<b>retraction</b>	The act of pulling or holding or drawing a part back. <i>Prey are grasped between the jaws upon tongue <b>retraction</b>.</i>
<b>secant</b>	A straight line that intersects a curve at two or more points.
<b>sectarian</b>	Rigidly following the doctrines of a sect or other group. <i>A Jewish <b>sectarian</b> who preached the redemption of the Gentiles.</i>
<b><u>section</u></b>	Divide into sections. <i>This last <b>section</b> of the questionnaire relates solely to training.</i>
<b>segment</b>	Divide into segments. <i>The cells <b>segmented</b>.</i>
<b>serration</b>	A row of notches. <i>The pliers had <b>serrations</b> to improve the grip.</i>
<b><u>sketchy</u></b>	(of a picture) resembling a sketch; consisting of outline without much detail. <i>The information they had was <b>sketchy</b>.</i>
<b><u>some</u></b>	To some extent quite a lot. <i>That was <b>some</b> party.</i>
<b><u>somewhat</u></b>	To certain extent or degree. <i>Matters have improved <b>somewhat</b> since then.</i>
<b>subdivision</b>	The action of subdividing or being subdivided. <i>Such an arrangement offers the possibility of <b>subdivision</b> into a series of identical spaces.</i>
<b>unfinished</b>	Not brought to the desired final state. <i>The building is still <b>unfinished</b>.</i>
<b>wreckage</b>	The remaining parts of something that has been wrecked. <i>They searched the <b>wreckage</b> for signs of survivors.</i>
