**The past tense of sed is sedded**

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## The Forms of Sed

Infinitive	<b>to sed</b>
Present Tense	<b>sed / seds</b>
Past Tense	<b>sedded</b>
Present Participle	<b>sedding</b>
Past Participle	<b>sedded</b>

## Conjugate Sed

**Sed in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
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I <b>sed</b>	We <b>sed</b>
You <b>sed</b>	You <b>sed</b>
He/She/It <b>sed</b> s	They <b>sed</b>

## **Sed in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
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I <b>am sedding</b>	We <b>are sedding</b>
You <b>are sedding</b>	You <b>are sedding</b>
He/She/It <b>is sedding</b>	They <b>are sedding</b>

## **Sed in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
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I <b>have sedded</b>	We <b>have sedded</b>
You <b>have sedded</b>	You <b>have sedded</b>
He/She/It <b>has sedded</b>	They <b>have sedded</b>

## **Sed in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
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I <b>have been sedding</b>	We <b>have been sedding</b>
You <b>have been sedding</b>	You <b>have been sedding</b>
He/She/It <b>has been sedding</b>	They <b>have been sedding</b>

## **Sed in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
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I <b>sedded</b>	We <b>sedded</b>
You <b>sedded</b>	You <b>sedded</b>
He/She/It <b>sedded</b>	They <b>sedded</b>

## **Sed in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was sedding</b>	We <b>were sedding</b>
You <b>were sedding</b>	You <b>were sedding</b>
He/She/It <b>was sedding</b>	They <b>were sedding</b>

**Sed in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had sedded</b>	We <b>had sedded</b>
You <b>had sedded</b>	You <b>had sedded</b>
He/She/It <b>had sedded</b>	They <b>had sedded</b>

**Sed in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had been sedding</b>	We <b>had been sedding</b>
You <b>had been sedding</b>	You <b>had been sedding</b>
He/She/It <b>had been sedding</b>	They <b>had been sedding</b>

**Sed in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will sed</b>	We <b>will sed</b>
You <b>will sed</b>	You <b>will sed</b>
He/She/It <b>will sed</b>	They <b>will sed</b>

**Sed in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be sedding</b>	We <b>will be sedding</b>
You <b>will be sedding</b>	You <b>will be sedding</b>
He/She/It <b>will be sedding</b>	They <b>will be sedding</b>

**Sed in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have sedded**

**We will have sedded**

**You will have sedded**

**You will have sedded**

**He/She/It will have sedded**

**They will have sedded**

**Sed in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been sedding**

**We will have been sedding**

**You will have been sedding**

**You will have been sedding**

**He/She/It will have been sedding**

**They will have been sedding**
