# **Conjugate Sedate**

### Sedate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I sedate	We <b>sedate</b>
You <b>sedate</b>	You <b>sedate</b>
He/She/It sedates	They <b>sedate</b>

## Sedate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am sedating	We <b>are sedating</b>
You <b>are sedating</b>	You <b>are sedating</b>
He/She/It is sedating	They are sedating

#### **Sedate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have sedated	We have sedated
You have sedated	You have sedated
He/She/It has sedated	They have sedated

## Sedate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been sedating	We have been sedating
You <b>have been sedating</b>	You have been sedating
He/She/It has been sedating	They have been sedating

## Sedate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I sedated	We <b>sedated</b>
You <b>sedated</b>	You <b>sedated</b>
He/She/It <b>sedated</b>	$They \ \textbf{sedated}$

## Sedate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was sedating	We were sedating
You were sedating	You were sedating
He/She/It was sedating	They were sedating

#### **Sedate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had sedated	We had sedated
You had sedated	You had sedated
He/She/It had sedated	They had sedated

### Sedate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been sedating	We had been sedating
You <b>had been sedating</b>	You had been sedating
He/She/It had been sedating	They had been sedating

## Sedate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will sedate	We will sedate
You <b>will sedate</b>	You <b>will sedate</b>
He/She/It will sedate	They will sedate

## Sedate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be sedating	We will be sedating
You <b>will be sedating</b>	You will be sedating
He/She/It will be sedating	They will be sedating

#### **Sedate in Future Perfect Tense**

#### Sedate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been sedating	We <b>will have been sedating</b>
You <b>will have been sedating</b>	You will have been sedating
He/She/It will have been sedating	They will have been sedating
