enchantress	A woman who uses magic to put someone or something under a spell.
femme fatale	A woman who is considered to be dangerously seductive.
lorelei	A Siren of German legend who lured boatmen in the Rhine to destruction.
mata hari	Dutch dancer who was executed by the French as a German spy in World War I (1876-1917.
<u>siren</u>	A device that makes a loud prolonged signal or warning sound. <i>Ambulance sirens</i> .
sorceress	A woman sorcerer.
<u>temptress</u>	A woman who tempts someone to do something, typically a sexually attractive woman who sets out to allure or seduce someone.
