<b>circe</b>	(Greek mythology) a sorceress who detained Odysseus on her island and turned his men into swine.
<b>delilah</b>	A woman who is considered to be dangerously seductive.
<b>enchantress</b>	A woman who uses magic to put someone or something under a spell.
<b>femme fatale</b>	A woman who is considered to be dangerously seductive.
<b>loirelei</b>	A Siren of German legend who lured boatmen in the Rhine to destruction.
<b>mata hari</b>	Dutch dancer who was executed by the French as a German spy in World War I (1876-1917).
<b><u>siren</u></b>	A device that makes a loud prolonged signal or warning sound. <i>Ambulance <b>sirens</b>.</i>
<b>sorceress</b>	A woman sorcerer.
<b><u>temptress</u></b>	A woman who tempts someone to do something, typically a sexually attractive woman who sets out to allure or seduce someone.
