## Associations of "Seek out" (30 Words)

<b>aboveground</b>	On or above the surface of the ground. <i><b>Aboveground</b> nuclear testing.</i>
<b>absentee</b>	A person who is expected or required to be present at a place or event but is not. <i><b>Absentee</b> pupils.</i>
<b><u>absenteeism</u></b>	Habitual absence from work. <i>High levels of <b>absenteeism</b> caused by low job motivation.</i>
<b><u>away</u></b>	An away match or win. <i>When he was ten or twelve feet <b>away</b> he stopped.</i>
<b>by</b>	In reserve; not for immediate use. <i>Put something <b>by</b> for her old age.</i>
<b><u>cave</u></b>	Explore caves as a sport. <i>He <b>caved</b> because his position had become untenable.</i>
<b>chase</b>	Make further investigation of an unresolved matter. <i>The dog <b>chased</b> after the stick.</i>
<b>exclude</b>	Prevent from entering; keep out. <i>The cost for the trip <b>excludes</b> food and beverages.</i>
<b><u>exhale</u></b>	Give out (breath or an odor). <i>The jungle <b>exhaled</b> mists of early morning.</i>
<b>explore</b>	Examine (organs) for diagnostic purposes. <i>He sets out to <b>explore</b> fundamental questions.</i>
<b><u>exterior</u></b>	The outer structure of a building. <i>An ideal spot to film <b>exteriors</b>.</i>
<b>find</b>	Get or find back recover the use of. <i>I <b>find</b> him to be obnoxious.</i>
<b>forage</b>	Food such as grass or hay for horses and cattle; fodder. <i>The birds <b>forage</b> for aquatic invertebrates insects and seeds.</i>

<b><u>gawk</u></b>	An awkward or shy person. <i>Let those country <b>gawks</b> dance to their hearts content.</i>
<b>goggle</b>	(of the eyes) open wide or protrude. <i>Their <b>goggle</b> mesmerizes even fishmongers.</i>
<b>grotto</b>	A small cave (usually with attractive features). <i>Visits to Father Christmas s <b>grotto</b>.</i>
<b>home</b>	Made done or intended for use in the home. <i>Canadian tariffs enabled United States lumber companies to raise prices at <b>home</b>.</i>
<b>hound</b>	Used in names of dogfishes e g nurse hound smooth hound. <i>A <b>hound</b> came running through the trees nose to the ground.</i>
<b>hunt</b>	Use a hound or a horse for hunting. <i>Lionesses <b>hunt</b> in groups.</i>
<b>look</b>	Look forward to the probable occurrence of. <i>My backyard <b>look</b> onto the pond.</i>
<b>poach</b>	Cook by simmering in a small amount of liquid. <i>A breakfast of <b>poached</b> egg and grilled bacon.</i>
<b><u>quest</u></b>	The act of searching for something. <i>The <b>quest</b> for a reliable vaccine has intensified.</i>
<b><u>rummage</u></b>	Find (something) by rummaging. <i>Open up the box and have a <b>rummage</b> around.</i>
<b>scavenger</b>	A person who searches for and collects discarded items. <i>A reputation as a <b>scavenger</b> of discarded odds and ends.</i>
<b><u>scour</u></b>	Remove dirt or unwanted matter by scouring. <i><b>Scour</b> the counter tops.</i>
<b>search</b>	Search or seek. <i>They are <b>searching</b> for the missing man in the entire county.</i>
<b>shooting</b>	The action or practice of shooting with a gun. <i>His <b>shooting</b> was slow but accurate.</i>
<b>sidelong</b>	Inclining or directed to one side - Bram Stoker. <i>Darting eyes looking <b>sidelong</b> out of a wizened face.</i>
<b>sideways</b>	From the side; obliquely. <i>Leaning <b>sideways</b>.</i>
<b><u>vault</u></b>	The act of jumping over an obstacle. <i>The masterpieces were deposited in the <b>vaults</b> of Swiss banks.</i>
