# **Conjugate Segregate**

#### Segregate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>segregate</b>	We <b>segregate</b>
You <b>segregate</b>	You <b>segregate</b>
He/She/It segregates	They <b>segregate</b>

### Segregate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am segregating	We are segregating
You are segregating	You <b>are segregating</b>
He/She/It is segregating	They are segregating

#### **Segregate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have segregated	We have segregated
You have segregated	You have segregated
He/She/It has segregated	They have segregated

### **Segregate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been segregating	We have been segregating
You <b>have been segregating</b>	You have been segregating
He/She/It has been segregating	They have been segregating

## Segregate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I segregated	We <b>segregated</b>
You <b>segregated</b>	You <b>segregated</b>
He/She/It <b>segregated</b>	They <b>segregated</b>

#### **Segregate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was segregating	We were segregating
You were segregating	You were segregating
He/She/It was segregating	They were segregating

#### **Segregate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had segregated	We had segregated
You had segregated	You had segregated
He/She/It had segregated	They had segregated

#### **Segregate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been segregating	We had been segregating
You had been segregating	You had been segregating
He/She/It had been segregating	They had been segregating

## Segregate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will segregate	We <b>will segregate</b>
You <b>will segregate</b>	You <b>will segregate</b>
He/She/It will segregate	They will segregate

## Segregate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be segregating	We <b>will be segregating</b>
You <b>will be segregating</b>	You <b>will be segregating</b>
He/She/It will be segregating	They will be segregating
