# **Conjugate Segue**

#### Segue in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I segue	We <b>segue</b>
You <b>segue</b>	You <b>segue</b>
He/She/It segues	They <b>segue</b>

#### Segue in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am segueing	We <b>are segueing</b>
You <b>are segueing</b>	You <b>are segueing</b>
He/She/It is segueing	They are segueing

#### **Segue in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have segued	We have segued
You have segued	You have segued
He/She/It has segued	They have segued

### **Segue in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been segueing	We have been segueing
You <b>have been segueing</b>	You have been segueing
He/She/It has been segueing	They have been segueing

## Segue in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I segued	We <b>segued</b>
You <b>segued</b>	You <b>segued</b>
He/She/It <b>segued</b>	They $\boldsymbol{segued}$

#### **Segue in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was segueing	We <b>were segueing</b>
You <b>were segueing</b>	You were segueing
He/She/It was segueing	They were segueing

#### **Segue in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had segued	We had segued
You had segued	You <b>had segued</b>
He/She/It had segued	They had segued

#### **Segue in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been segueing	We had been segueing
You <b>had been segueing</b>	You had been segueing
He/She/It had been segueing	They had been segueing

## Segue in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will segue	We <b>will segue</b>
You <b>will segue</b>	You <b>will segue</b>
He/She/It will segue	They will segue

## **Segue in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be segueing	We will be segueing
You <b>will be segueing</b>	You <b>will be segueing</b>
He/She/It will be segueing	They will be segueing

#### **Segue in Future Perfect Tense**

I will have been segueing	We <b>will have been segueing</b>

He/She/It will have been segueing They will have been segueing
