Mercenaries who had allowed **greed** to overtake their principles.

haughtiness The appearance or quality of being arrogantly superior and disdainful.

Her air of **haughtiness**.

hubris Excessive pride or self-confidence.

The self assured **hubris** among economists was shaken in the late 1980s.



independent An independent person or body.

A series of **independent** judgments.

individual Characteristic of a particular person or thing.

Individual drops of rain.

individualist A self-centred or egotistical person.

Individualist attitudes.

Marked by or expressing individuality; unconventional.

individualistic An individualistic way of dressing.

narcissism An exceptional interest in and admiration for yourself.

pomposityThe quality of being pompous; self-importance.

His reputation for arrogance and **pomposity**.

prideBe proud of.

I went to **pride** as a teenager before I was ready to come out.

Concerned chiefly or only with yourself and your advantage to the

selfish exclusion of others- Maria Weston Chapman.

I joined them for **selfish** reasons.

selfishness The quality or state of being selfish; lack of consideration for other people.

An act of pure **selfishness**.

Marked by excessive complacency or self-satisfaction.

A **smug** glow of self congratulation.

(psychoanalysis) that part of the unconscious mind that acts as a

superego conscience.

True schizophrenias lack the **superego** elements present in paranoia.

vainglorious Excessively proud of oneself or one's achievements; overly vain.

This **vainglorious** boast of personal infallibility.

vainglory Outspoken conceit.

His **vainglory** put the Republic at risk.

The quality of being valueless or futile.

The **vanity** of human wishes.

waken Cause to become awake or conscious.
