## Associations of "Self destructive" (30 Words)

<b>arrogance</b>	Overbearing pride evidenced by a superior manner toward inferiors. <i>The <b>arrogance</b> of this man is astounding.</i>
<b>caustic</b>	A caustic substance. <i>A <b>caustic</b> cleaner.</i>
<b>centered</b>	Being or placed in the center.
<b>conceit</b>	The trait of being unduly vain and conceited false pride. <i>He was puffed up with <b>conceit</b>.</i>
<b>corrode</b>	Cause to deteriorate due to the action of water, air, or an acid. <i>The self centred climate <b>corrodes</b> ideals and concerns about social justice.</i>
<b>corrosive</b>	A corrosive substance. <i><b>Corrosive</b> criticism.</i>
<b>crushing</b>	Physically or spiritually devastating; often used in combination. <i>The news came as a <b>crushing</b> blow.</i>
<b>ego</b>	(in metaphysics) a conscious thinking subject. <i>He needed a boost to his <b>ego</b>.</i>
<b>egocentric</b>	An egocentric person. <i><b>Egocentric</b> loners with an overinflated sense of self worth.</i>
<b>egocentrism</b>	Concern for your own interests and welfare.
<b>egoism</b>	(ethics) the theory that the pursuit of your own welfare in the basis of morality.
<b>egoist</b>	A self-centered person with little regard for others.
<b>egotism</b>	The fact of being excessively conceited or absorbed in oneself. <i>In his arrogance and <b>egotism</b> he underestimated Gill.</i>
<b>egotist</b>	A conceited and self-centered person. <i>He is a self absorbed <b>egotist</b>.</i>
<b>erosive</b>	Wearing away by friction. <i>The <b>erosive</b> effects of waves on the shoreline.</i>

<b>greed</b>	Excessive desire to acquire or possess more (especially more material wealth) than one needs or deserves. <i><b>Greed</b> has taken over football.</i>
<b>iconoclasm</b>	The rejection or destruction of religious images as heretical; the doctrine of iconoclasts.
<b>individualism</b>	A belief in the importance of the individual and the virtue of self-reliance and personal independence. <i>A culture that celebrates <b>individualism</b> and wealth.</i>
<b>individualist</b>	Relating to or denoting a social theory favouring freedom of action for individuals over collective or state control. <i><b>Individualist</b> attitudes.</i>
<b>individualistic</b>	Marked by or expressing individuality; unconventional. <i>An <b>individualistic</b> way of dressing.</i>
<b>narcissism</b>	An exceptional interest in and admiration for yourself.
<b>pomposity</b>	The quality of being pompous; self-importance. <i>His reputation for arrogance and <b>pomposity</b>.</i>
<b>pride</b>	Confidence and self-respect as expressed by members of a group, typically one that has been socially marginalized, on the basis of their shared identity, culture, and experience. <i>I went to <b>pride</b> as a teenager before I was ready to come out.</i>
<b>ruinous</b>	Disastrous or destructive. <i>A <b>ruinous</b> course of action.</i>
<b>selfish</b>	(of a person, action, or motive) lacking consideration for other people; concerned chiefly with one's own personal profit or pleasure. <i>I joined them for <b>selfish</b> reasons.</i>
<b>selfishness</b>	The quality or state of being selfish; lack of consideration for other people. <i>An act of pure <b>selfishness</b>.</i>
<b>superego</b>	That part of the unconscious mind that acts as a conscience. <i>The father is the model for the <b>superego</b>.</i>
<b>vainglorious</b>	Excessively proud of oneself or one's achievements; overly vain. <i>This <b>vainglorious</b> boast of personal infallibility.</i>
<b>vanity</b>	The quality of being worthless or futile. <i>A <b>vanity</b> press.</i>
<b>vitriolic</b>	Of a substance, especially a strong acid; capable of destroying or eating away by chemical action. <i><b>Vitriolic</b> attacks on the politicians.</i>
