egoism (ethics) the theory that the pursuit of your own welfare in the basis of

morality.

egoist A self-centered person with little regard for others.

egotism

The fact of being excessively conceited or absorbed in oneself.

In his arrogance and **eqotism** he underestimated Gill.

egotist A conceited and self-centered person.

He is a self absorbed **eqotist**.

erosive Wearing away by friction.

The **erosive** effects of waves on the shoreline.



greed

Excessive desire to acquire or possess more (especially more material

wealth) than one needs or deserves.

Greed has taken over football.

The rejection or destruction of religious images as heretical; the doctrine iconoclasm

of iconoclasts.

A belief in the importance of the individual and the virtue of self-reliance

individualism and personal independence.

A culture that celebrates **individualism** and wealth.

Relating to or denoting a social theory favouring freedom of action for

individualist individuals over collective or state control.

Individualist attitudes.

Marked by or expressing individuality; unconventional. individualistic An individualistic way of dressing.

narcissism An exceptional interest in and admiration for yourself.

The quality of being pompous; self-importance. pomposity

His reputation for arrogance and **pomposity**.

Confidence and self-respect as expressed by members of a group, typically

one that has been socially marginalized, on the basis of their shared

<u>pride</u> identity, culture, and experience.

I went to **pride** as a teenager before I was ready to come out.

Disastrous or destructive. ruinous

A **ruinous** course of action.

(of a person, action, or motive) lacking consideration for other people;

selfish concerned chiefly with one's own personal profit or pleasure.

I joined them for **selfish** reasons.

The quality or state of being selfish; lack of consideration for other people. selfishness

An act of pure **selfishness**.

That part of the unconscious mind that acts as a conscience.

superego The father is the model for the **superego**.

Excessively proud of oneself or one's achievements; overly vain. vainglorious

This **vainglorious** boast of personal infallibility.

The quality of being worthless or futile.

vanity A **vanity** press.

Of a substance, especially a strong acid; capable of destroying or eating

vitriolic away by chemical action.

Vitriolic attacks on the politicians.
