## Associations of "Self taught" (30 Words)

<a href="#">absenteeism</a>	Habitual absence from work. <i>High levels of <b>absenteeism</b> caused by low job motivation.</i>
<b>arrogance</b>	Overbearing pride evidenced by a superior manner toward inferiors. <i>The <b>arrogance</b> of this man is astounding.</i>
<b>bragging</b>	Exhibiting or characterized by excessive pride or boastfulness. <i>A little honest <b>bragging</b> doesn't hurt anyone.</i>
<a href="#">centered</a>	Being or placed in the center.
<b>conceit</b>	The trait of being unduly vain and conceited false pride. <i>The director's brilliant <b>conceit</b> was to film this tale in black and white.</i>
<a href="#">ego</a>	(psychoanalysis) the conscious mind. <i>He needed a boost to his <b>ego</b>.</i>
<a href="#">egocentric</a>	An egocentric person. <i><b>Egocentric</b> spatial perception.</i>
<b>egocentrism</b>	Concern for your own interests and welfare.
<b>egoism</b>	(ethics) the theory that the pursuit of your own welfare in the basis of morality.
<b>egoist</b>	A conceited and self-centered person.
<b>egotism</b>	The fact of being excessively conceited or absorbed in oneself. <i>In his arrogance and <b>egotism</b> he underestimated Gill.</i>
<b>egotist</b>	A conceited and self-centered person. <i>He is a self absorbed <b>egotist</b>.</i>
<b>esprit</b>	The quality of being lively, vivacious, or witty.
<b>greed</b>	Reprehensible acquisitiveness; insatiable desire for wealth (personified as one of the deadly sins). <i><b>Greed</b> has taken over football.</i>

<b>individualism</b>	The quality of being individual. <i>Encouragement has been given to <b>individualism</b> free enterprise and the pursuit of profit.</i>
<b>individualist</b>	A person who is independent and self-reliant. <i>Selfish <b>individualists</b> thinking only of themselves.</i>
<b>individualistic</b>	More interested in individual people than in society as a whole. <i><b>Individualistic</b> cultures where individuals strive for self realization.</i>
<b>introspective</b>	Characterized by or given to introspection. <i>He grew withdrawn and <b>introspective</b>.</i>
<b>modern</b>	Belonging to the modern era since the Middle Ages. <i>They do not have <b>modern</b> weapons.</i>
<b>morale</b>	The spirit of a group that makes the members want the group to succeed. <i>The team s <b>morale</b> was high.</i>
<b>narcissism</b>	Selfishness, involving a sense of entitlement, a lack of empathy, and a need for admiration, as characterizing a personality type.
<b>pedagogy</b>	The activities of educating or instructing; activities that impart knowledge or skill. <i>The relationship between applied linguistics and language <b>pedagogy</b>.</i>
<b>pomposity</b>	Lack of elegance as a consequence of being pompous and puffed up with vanity. <i>His reputation for arrogance and <b>pomposity</b>.</i>
<b>pride</b>	A public event, typically involving a parade, held to celebrate LGBT identities, culture, and experience. <i>The males in the <b>pride</b> are very tolerant towards all the cubs.</i>
<b>selfish</b>	(of a person, action, or motive) lacking consideration for other people; concerned chiefly with one's own personal profit or pleasure. <i>I joined them for <b>selfish</b> reasons.</i>
<b>selfishness</b>	The quality or state of being selfish; lack of consideration for other people. <i>An act of pure <b>selfishness</b>.</i>
<b>superego</b>	(psychoanalysis) that part of the unconscious mind that acts as a conscience. <i>True schizophrenias lack the <b>superego</b> elements present in paranoia.</i>
<b>vainglorious</b>	Excessively proud of oneself or one's achievements; overly vain. <i>This <b>vainglorious</b> boast of personal infallibility.</i>
<b>vainglory</b>	Excessive pride in oneself or one's achievements; excessive vanity. <i>His <b>vainglory</b> put the Republic at risk.</i>
<b>vanity</b>	The quality of being valueless or futile. <i>A <b>vanity</b> press.</i>
