marketer Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.

A leading manufacturer and **marketer** of medical products.

(in historical contexts) a person involved in trade or commerce.

merchant

A tea merchant.

A person or group who spreads or promotes an idea, view, etc.

A **purveyor** of traditional Christian values.

A person or business that sells goods to the public in relatively small

retailer quantities for use or consumption rather than for resale.

As a writer I see myself as a **retailer** of Big Ideas.

shopkeeper A merchant who owns or manages a shop.

stockist One (as a retailer or distributor) that stocks goods.

One of the country's largest **stockist**s of Italian designer labels.

Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity.

The company has to pay **supplier**s within 90 days of purchase.

trader A merchant ship.

trafficker A person who deals or trades in something illegal.

The most notorious arms **trafficker** in the world.

vender Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.



vendor

Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. *An Italian ice cream vendor*.




Usage Examples of "Seller" as a noun

purchaser A person who buys something; a buyer.

salesman A man salesperson.

selling The exchange of goods for an agreed sum of money.

shopkeeper The owner and manager of a shop.

store A depository for goods.
