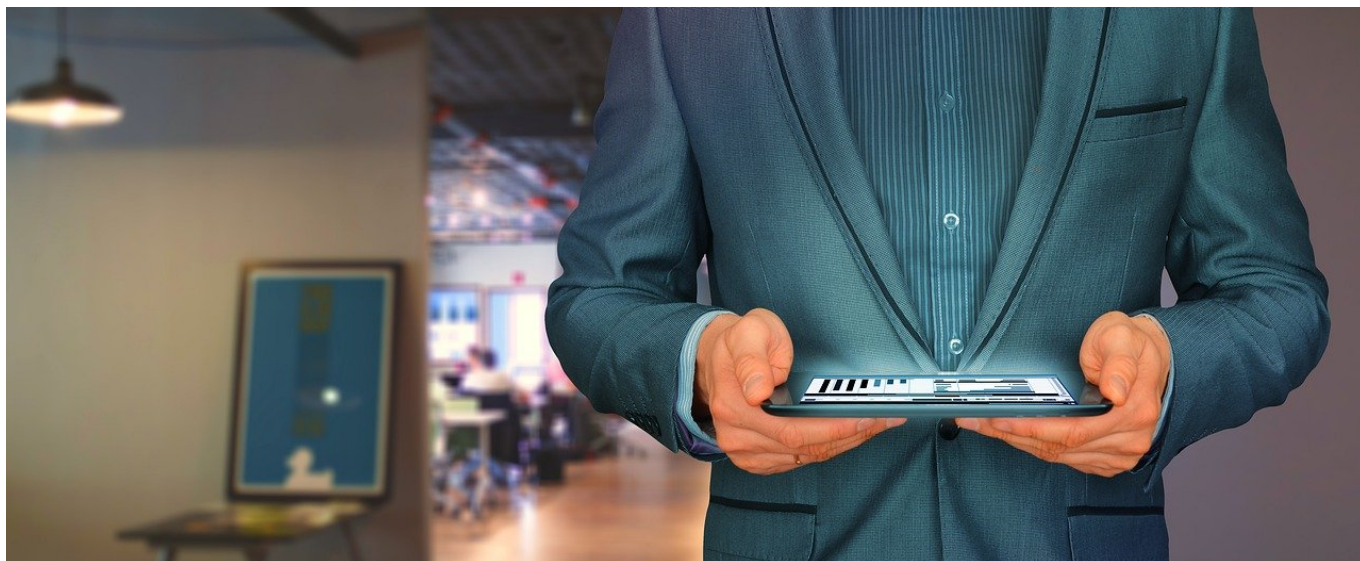

Definitions of "Seller" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “seller” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.*
- *A product that sells in some specified way.*
- *A person who sells something.*



Synonyms of "Seller" as a noun (12 Words)

dealer	The person who distributes the playing cards in a card game. <i>A brash young dealer arrived on the dealing floor.</i>
marketer	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. <i>A leading manufacturer and marketer of medical products.</i>
<u>merchant</u>	(in historical contexts) a person involved in trade or commerce. <i>A tea merchant.</i>
purveyor	A person or group who spreads or promotes an idea, view, etc. <i>A purveyor of traditional Christian values.</i>
retailer	A person or business that sells goods to the public in relatively small quantities for use or consumption rather than for resale. <i>As a writer I see myself as a retailer of Big Ideas.</i>
shopkeeper	A merchant who owns or manages a shop.
stockist	One (as a retailer or distributor) that stocks goods. <i>One of the country's largest stockists of Italian designer labels.</i>
<u>supplier</u>	Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity. <i>The company has to pay suppliers within 90 days of purchase.</i>
trader	A merchant ship.
trafficker	A person who deals or trades in something illegal. <i>The most notorious arms trafficker in the world.</i>
vender	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.

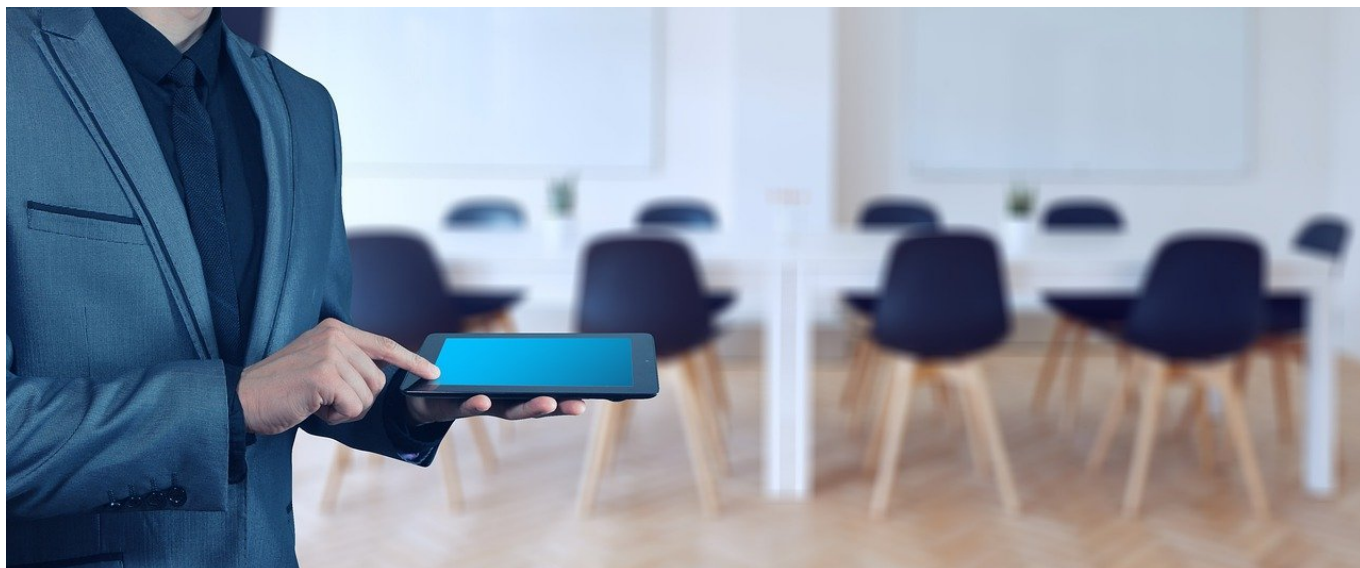
Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.

Usage Examples of "Seller" as a noun

- *Street sellers of newspapers, flowers, etc.*

- *The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.*



Associations of "Seller" (30 Words)

auction	Sell or offer for sale at an auction. <i>The books are expected to fetch a six figure sum at tomorrow s auction.</i>
automat	A cafeteria in which food and drink were obtained from slot machines.
buy	Be worth or be capable of buying. <i>Wine is rarely a good buy in duty free shops.</i>
buyer	A person employed to select and purchase stock or materials for a large retail or manufacturing business.
clerk	Work as a clerk as in the legal business. <i>Eleven of those who left college this year are clerking in auction stores.</i>
fishmonger	Someone who sells fish.
huckster	A person who writes radio or tv advertisements. <i>He was huckstering a video.</i>
<u>market</u>	The securities markets in the aggregate. <i>They wanted to browse around the street market.</i>
marketer	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. <i>A leading manufacturer and marketer of medical products.</i>
<u>marketplace</u>	An open space where a market is or was formerly held. <i>They were driven from the marketplace.</i>

<u>merchant</u>	In historical contexts relating to merchants or commerce. <i>Prosperous merchants and clothiers had established a middle class.</i>
outsell	Be sold more often than other, similar products. <i>The new Toyota outsells the Honda by a wide margin.</i>
peddle	Sell (an illegal drug or stolen item). <i>He peddled printing materials around the country.</i>
peddler	Someone who travels about selling his wares (as on the streets or at carnivals). <i>A drug peddler.</i>
price	Determine the price of. <i>He puts a high price on his services.</i>
purchaser	A person who buys something; a buyer. <i>One of the club's prospective purchasers.</i>
<u>salesman</u>	A man salesperson. <i>An insurance salesman.</i>
salesperson	A salesman or saleswoman (used as a neutral alternative).
sell	Sell all of one's property possessions or assets. <i>The brothers sell shoes.</i>
selling	The exchange of goods for an agreed sum of money.
shopkeeper	The owner and manager of a shop.
<u>store</u>	A depository for goods. <i>A health food store.</i>
subcontractor	A firm or person that carries out work for a company as part of a larger project.
trader	Someone who purchases and maintains an inventory of goods to be sold.
transferee	(law) someone to whom a title or property is conveyed.
undersell	Sell cheaper than one's competition. <i>She feels she was underselling herself by putting her disability high on her CV.</i>
vend	Sell or offer for sale from place to place. <i>There was a man vending sticky cakes and ices.</i>
<u>vendor</u>	A person or company offering something for sale, especially a trader in the street. <i>An Italian ice cream vendor.</i>
vintner	A wine merchant.
wholesale	At a wholesale price. <i>The manufacturer's wholesale price.</i>
