<b>advancement</b>	The process of promoting a cause or plan. <i>Technological <b>advancements</b>.</i>
<b>arranged</b>	Deliberately arranged for effect. <i>Comfortable chairs <b>arranged</b> around the fireplace.</i>
<b>deactivation</b>	The act of deactivating or making ineffective (as a bomb).
<b>developmental</b>	Of or relating to or constituting development. <i><b>Developmental</b> problems.</i>
<b>emend</b>	Make improvements or corrections to. <i>The year of his death might need to be <b>emended</b> to 652.</i>
<b>evolutionary</b>	Relating to or denoting the process by which different kinds of living organism are believed to have developed from earlier forms. <i>Chance enters into the <b>evolutionary</b> process in the form of naturally occurring random mutations.</i>
<b>expedite</b>	Process fast and efficiently. <i>I will try to <b>expedite</b> the matter.</i>
<b>fixing</b>	A screw, bolt, or other item used to fasten or assemble building material, furniture, or equipment. <i>Several laws restricted the <b>fixing</b> of retail prices.</i>
<b>improvement</b>	A condition superior to an earlier condition. <i>Their <b>improvements</b> increased the value of the property.</i>
<b>in</b>	Expressing movement with the result that someone or something becomes enclosed or surrounded by something else. <i>The train got <b>in</b> very late.</i>
<a href="#">lay</a>	The laying of eggs or the period during which they are laid. <i>He was making newspaper knots before <b>laying</b> a fire in the fireplace.</i>
<b>located</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally <b>located</b> urban land.</i>

<b>match</b>	Make equal uniform corresponding or matching. <i>If you drop a <b>match</b> in there the whole place will explode.</i>
<b>matching</b>	Intentionally matched. <i>The college will provide <b>matching</b> funds to complete the project.</i>
<b>ordered</b>	Disposed or placed in a particular kind of order. <i>An <b>ordered</b> sequence.</i>
<b>organized</b>	Being a member of or formed into a labor union. <i><b>Organized</b> medicine.</i>
<u><b>pair</b></u>	Of animals form a pair for breeding purposes. <i>A <b>pair</b> of gloves.</i>
<u><b>podium</b></u>	Of a competitor in a sporting event finish first second or third so as to appear on a podium to receive an award. <i>He was at the <b>podium</b> facing an expectant conference crowd.</i>
<u><b>posit</b></u>	Logic a proposition that is accepted as true in order to provide a basis for logical reasoning. <i><b>Deposit</b> the suitcase on the bench.</i>
<b>procedure</b>	A process or series of acts especially of a practical or mechanical nature involved in a particular form of work. <i>The <b>procedure</b> is carried out under general anaesthetic.</i>
<u><b>proceed</b></u>	(of an action) carry on or continue. <i>The consortium could <b>proceed</b> with the plan.</i>
<b>processing</b>	Preparing or putting through a prescribed procedure. <i>The <b>processing</b> of ore to obtain minerals.</i>
<u><b>progression</b></u>	A movement forward. <i>Good opportunities for career <b>progression</b>.</i>
<b>put</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>He <b>put</b> her to the torture.</i>
<b>sere</b>	(used especially of vegetation) having lost all moisture. <i>The desert was edged with <b>sere</b> vegetation.</i>
<b>situate</b>	Situated. <i>Amy is now comfortably <b>situated</b>.</i>
<u><b>situated</b></u>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely <b>situated</b> on a quiet riverbank.</i>
<b>step</b>	Step aerobics. <i>He heard foot<b>steps</b> on the porch.</i>
<b>systematically</b>	According to a fixed plan or system; methodically. <i>We searched <b>systematically</b> for evidence.</i>

**upstage**

Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience.  
*When the dog entered the stage he **upstaged** the actress.*
