- A ledge of rock or protruding strip of land.
- A submarine bank, or a part of the continental shelf.
- A flat length of wood or other rigid material, attached to a wall or forming part of a piece of furniture, that provides a surface for the storage or display of objects.
- A support that consists of a horizontal surface for holding objects.
- A projecting ridge on a mountain or submerged under water.

bank	An elevation in the seabed or a riverbed a mudbank or sandbank. <i>He sat on the <b>bank</b> of the river and watched the currents.</i>
<u>bar</u>	The crossbar of a goal. The orchestra omitted the last twelve <b>bar</b> s of the song.
bracket	A category falling within certain defined limits. With the March Madness tournament half the fun is filling out your <b>bracket</b> .
ledge	A window ledge. <i>He heaved himself up over a <b>ledge</b>.</i>
rack	A stack of digital effects units for a guitar or other instrument. <i>That chick s got a nice <b>rack</b>.</i>
reef	A submerged ridge of rock or coral near the surface of the water.
sandbank	A submerged bank of sand near a shore or in a river; can be exposed at low tide.



#### shoal A large number of people or things.

**Shoal** sof people were coming up the drive.

sill A flat (usually horizontal) mass of igneous rock between two layers of older sedimentary rock.



# Associations of "Shelf" (30 Words)

<u>bedroom</u>	A room used primarily for sleeping. All parents dream of children who tidy their <b>bedroom</b> s without being asked.
bookcase	An open cabinet containing shelves on which to keep books.
box	Put into a box. He rummaged through a <b>box</b> of spare parts.
<u>cabinet</u>	A storage compartment for clothes and valuables; usually it has a lock. A <i>cabinet meeting</i> .
cleaver	A tool with a heavy, broad blade, used by butchers for chopping meat. <i>A meat cleaver</i> .



<u>closet</u>	A small room, especially one used for storing things or for private study. <i>He has a <b>closet</b> full of designer suits.</i>
<u>console</u>	A small table fixed to a wall or designed to stand against a wall. The bust of Napoleon stood on a <b>console</b> .
dishwasher	A machine for washing dishes automatically.
distribution	The commercial activity of transporting and selling goods from a producer to a consumer. The <b>distribution</b> of nerve fibers.
drawer	An artist skilled at drawing. <i>Queen Victoria was notoriously careless with her</i> <b>drawer</b> s.
fridge	A refrigerator in which the coolant is pumped around by an electric motor. She put the carton of milk back in the <b>fridge</b> .
furnishing	The act of providing a house or room with furniture and other removable items such as shelves, carpets, appliances, etc. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings</i> .
<u>furniture</u>	Pieces of wood or metal placed round or between metal type to make blank spaces and fasten the type in the chase. <i>They had too much furniture for the small apartment.</i>
hatchet	A small axe with a short handle for use in one hand.
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. A fully fitted <b>kitchen</b> at a bargain price.
knickknack	Miscellaneous curios.
lab	A laboratory. A science <b>lab</b> .
lathe	Shape with a lathe. I have <b>lathe</b> d metal in a machine shop.
overload	Become overloaded. An <b>overload</b> of stress.
packet	Make up into or wrap up in a packet. Reusable alternatives will be available to encourage customers to stop using the <b>packet</b> s.
<u>parcel</u>	Make something into a parcel by wrapping it. A <b>parcel</b> of shares.
plank	Cook and serve on a plank. <i>He <b>plank</b>ed himself into the sofa.</i>
refectory	A communal dining-hall (usually in a monastery.



<u>room</u>	Provide with a shared room or lodging. <i>There s room for improvement in the way the programme is managed.</i>
<u>sofa</u>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <b>Sofa</b> cushions.
space	The unlimited expanse in which everything is located. <i>The laboratory s floor <b>space</b></i> .
table	A piece of furniture with tableware for a meal laid out on it. More than 200 amendments to the bill have already been <b>table</b> d.
unoccupied	Not leased to or occupied by a tenant. The house has been <b>unoccupied</b> for some time.
<u>volume</u>	A scroll of parchment or papyrus containing written matter. <i>The third <b>volume</b> was missing.</i>
wooden	Made of wood. She closed the heavy <b>wooden</b> door.
