Infinitive	<b>to shin</b>
Present Tense	<b>shin / shins</b>
Past Tense	<b>shinned</b>
Present Participle	<b>shinning</b>
Past Participle	<b>shinned</b>

## Conjugate Shin

**Shin in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>shin</b>	We <b>shin</b>
You <b>shin</b>	You <b>shin</b>
He/She/It <b>shins</b>	They <b>shin</b>

## **Shin in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am shinning</b>	We <b>are shinning</b>
You <b>are shinning</b>	You <b>are shinning</b>
He/She/It <b>is shinning</b>	They <b>are shinning</b>

## **Shin in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have shinned</b>	We <b>have shinned</b>
You <b>have shinned</b>	You <b>have shinned</b>
He/She/It <b>has shinned</b>	They <b>have shinned</b>

## **Shin in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been shinning</b>	We <b>have been shinning</b>
You <b>have been shinning</b>	You <b>have been shinning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been shinning</b>	They <b>have been shinning</b>

I <b>shinned</b>	We <b>shinned</b>
You <b>shinned</b>	You <b>shinned</b>
He/She/It <b>shinned</b>	They <b>shinned</b>

<b>I was shinning</b>	<b>We were shinning</b>
<b>You were shinning</b>	<b>You were shinning</b>
<b>He/She/It was shinning</b>	<b>They were shinning</b>

**Shin in Past Perfect Tense**

<b>I had shinned</b>	<b>We had shinned</b>
<b>You had shinned</b>	<b>You had shinned</b>
<b>He/She/It had shinned</b>	<b>They had shinned</b>

**Shin in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been shinning</b>	<b>We had been shinning</b>
<b>You had been shinning</b>	<b>You had been shinning</b>
<b>He/She/It had been shinning</b>	<b>They had been shinning</b>

**Shin in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>I will shin</b>	<b>We will shin</b>
<b>You will shin</b>	<b>You will shin</b>
<b>He/She/It will shin</b>	<b>They will shin</b>

**Shin in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>I will be shinning</b>	<b>We will be shinning</b>
<b>You will be shinning</b>	<b>You will be shinning</b>
<b>He/She/It will be shinning</b>	<b>They will be shinning</b>

**Shin in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have shinned**

**We will have shinned**

**You will have shinned**

**You will have shinned**

**He/She/It will have shinned**

**They will have shinned**

**Shin in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been shinning**

**We will have been shinning**

**You will have been shinning**

**You will have been shinning**

**He/She/It will have been shinning**

**They will have been shinning**
