incredible	Beyond belief or understanding. <i>The noise from the crowd was incredible.</i>
marvelous	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>A marvelous collection of rare books.</i>
outrageous	Greatly exceeding bounds of reason or moderation. <i>Her outrageous leotards and sexy routines.</i>

prodigious	Remarkably or impressively great in extent, size, or degree. <i>The young Mozart s prodigious talents.</i>
puzzled	Filled with bewilderment. <i>She looked puzzled and angry with him.</i>
raunchy	Shabby or grubby. <i>His raunchy new novel.</i>
redoubtable	Worthy of respect or honor. <i>The redoubtable ladies.</i>
revelation	The last book of the New Testament recounting a divine revelation of the future to St John. <i>An attempt to reconcile Darwinian theories with biblical revelation.</i>
saintliness	The quality of resembling a saint. <i>Her selfless behaviour borders on saintliness.</i>
sensational	Causing intense interest, curiosity, or emotion. <i>A sensational murder trial.</i>
shattering	Very shocking or upsetting. <i>The shattering tones of the enormous carillon.</i>
shock	Collect or gather into shocks. <i>He shocked so easily.</i>
spectacular	Beautiful in a dramatic and eye-catching way. <i>A spectacular rise in prices.</i>
staggering	Deeply shocking; astonishing. <i>The amount of money required was staggering.</i>
startling	Very surprising, astonishing, or remarkable. <i>He bore a startling likeness to their father.</i>
surprised	Taken unawares or suddenly and feeling wonder or astonishment. <i>There was a surprised silence.</i>
surprising	Causing surprise; unexpected. <i>Leaped up with surprising agility.</i>
unexpectedly	In a way that was not expected or regarded as likely. <i>Tourist chiefs reported unexpectedly high visitor numbers.</i>
wonderful	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>The climate was wonderful all the year round.</i>
wondering	Characterized by or expressive of a desire to know something; curious. <i>Unsure where she was leading to I cast her a wondering look.</i>
