## Associations of "Shoot yourself in the foot" (30 Words)

<b><u>ammunition</u></b>	A supply or quantity of bullets and shells. <i>Guns <b>ammunition</b> and explosives.</i>
<b>breech</b>	Dress a boy in breeches after he had been in petticoats since birth. <i><b>Breech</b> presentation occurs in up to 3 per cent of pregnancies at term.</i>
<b><u>bullet</u></b>	A pitch thrown with maximum velocity. <i>Your record s bad but it s doubtful they ll give you the <b>bullet</b>.</i>
<b>caliber</b>	Diameter of a tube or gun barrel. <i>An executive of low <b>caliber</b>.</i>
<b>cannon</b>	Fire a cannon. <i>His shot <b>cannoned</b> off the crossbar.</i>
<b>cartridge</b>	Ammunition consisting of a cylindrical casing containing an explosive charge and a bullet; fired from a rifle or handgun. <i>He loaded a <b>cartridge</b> of fresh tape into the tape deck.</i>
<b>catapult</b>	Shoot forth or launch as if from a catapult. <i>The enemy <b>catapulted</b> rocks towards the fort.</i>
<b>firearm</b>	A portable gun. <i>Jones pleaded guilty to possessing a <b>firearm</b> with criminal intent.</i>
<b>firing</b>	The act of firing weapons or artillery at an enemy. <i>The colours had suffered in the <b>firing</b> and were dull from overheating.</i>
<b>foam</b>	Become bubbly or frothy or foaming. <i>A beer with a thick head of <b>foam</b>.</i>
<b>fusillade</b>	Attack with fusillade. <i>The Mahdi s adherents <b>fusilladed</b> his palace at Khartoum.</i>
<b>grenade</b>	A glass receptacle containing chemicals which are released when the receptacle is thrown and broken, used for testing drains and extinguishing fires.

<b>gun</b>	Used as a nickname for a ship's gunnery officer. <i>It's encouraging to note that Schwarzenegger wasn't born with massive <b>guns</b>.</i>
<b>gunshot</b>	The range of a gun. <i>We bore down and came nearly within <b>gunshot</b>.</i>
<b>hammock</b>	A hanging bed of canvas or rope netting (usually suspended between two trees); swings easily.
<b>ignition</b>	The mechanism for bringing about ignition in an internal combustion engine typically activated by a key or switch. <i>A small amount of diesel fuel must be injected to allow <b>ignition</b>.</i>
<b>misfire</b>	(especially of a plan) fail to produce the intended result. <i>The guns <b>misfired</b>.</i>
<b>musket</b>	A muzzle-loading shoulder gun with a long barrel; formerly used by infantrymen. <i>A volley of <b>musket</b> fire.</i>
<b>muzzle</b>	Fit with a muzzle. <i><b>Muzzle</b> the dog to prevent it from biting strangers.</i>
<b>paw</b>	Scrape with the paws. <i>Some overweight Casanova had tried to <b>paw</b> her.</i>
<b>pistol</b>	Shoot someone with a pistol. <i>When we first met he was a <b>pistol</b> full of ideals and a natural leader.</i>
<b>revolver</b>	A door consisting of four orthogonal partitions that rotate about a central pivot; a door designed to equalize the air pressure in tall buildings.
<b>rifle</b>	Troops armed with rifles. <i>He lifted the <b>rifle</b> to his shoulder and fired.</i>
<b>salvo</b>	A simultaneous discharge of artillery or other guns in a battle. <i>A deafening <b>salvo</b> of shots rang out.</i>
<b>shooting</b>	The action or practice of shooting with a gun. <i>The events that led up to the <b>shooting</b> of the man.</i>
<b>shot</b>	A heavy ball thrown by a shot putter. <i>Chatoyant or <b>shot</b> silk.</i>
<b>shotgun</b>	Shoot at or kill with a shotgun. <i>I took the <b>shotgun</b> seat.</i>
<b>sling</b>	Hoist or transfer something with a sling. <i>700 men armed only with <b>slings</b>.</i>
<b>toe</b>	Touch with the toe. <i>Socks that were holed at the <b>toes</b>.</i>

**webbed** (of a band or strip of tough material) made from webbing or similar fabric.
