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Associations of "Side by side" (30 Words)

adjoin	Be next to and joined with (a building, room, or piece of land). <i>Canada adjoins the U S.</i>
apart	Not taken into account or excluded from consideration. <i>Joking apart they do a really remarkable job.</i>
aside	In a different direction. <i>He pushed his plate aside.</i>
away	An away match or win. <i>Sent the children away to boarding school.</i>
bevel	Cut a bevel on shape to a bevel. <i>A very small 45 bevel is ground on the top surface.</i>
digression	A message that departs from the main subject. <i>Let s return to the main topic after that brief digression.</i>
distal	Situated away from the centre of the body or from the point of attachment. <i>The distal zone is characterized by pyroclastic flow deposits.</i>
edge	Provide with an edge. <i>He had an edge on the competition.</i>
exterior	A person’s behaviour and demeanour, especially when at variance with their true character. <i>Exterior noise.</i>
external	Happening or arising or located outside or beyond some limits or especially surface. <i>For external application only.</i>
extremity	The outermost or farthest region or point. <i>The peninsula s western extremity.</i>
facade	A showy misrepresentation intended to conceal something unpleasant. <i>Her flawless public facade masked private despair.</i>

far	Distant from a point seen as central; extreme. <i>He had not travelled far.</i>
flank	A cut of meat from the flank of an animal. <i>Cherry red sofas flanked the enormous fireplace.</i>
lateral	Involving lateral thinking. <i>Cut back all the laterals to within two buds of the main stem.</i>
laterally	In a way that involves lateral thinking. <i>Use slide steps to move laterally.</i>
left	Location near or direction toward the left side i.e. the side to the north when a person or object faces east. <i>The batter flied out to left.</i>
margin	A line ruled on paper to mark off a margin. <i>The margin of victory.</i>
marginal	Of questionable or minimal quality. <i>She is defending a key marginal for the Tories.</i>
marginally	To only a limited extent; slightly. <i>He s marginally worse than he was.</i>
nearby	Not far away in relative terms. <i>His four sisters live nearby.</i>
northern	(of a wind) blowing from the north. <i>She had a broad northern accent.</i>
oblique	An oblique muscle. <i>An oblique abdominal muscle.</i>
outermost	Situated at the farthest possible point from a center. <i>The outermost layer of the earth.</i>
outwardly	In outward appearance. <i>Outwardly featureless modern offices.</i>
parenthesis	Either of two punctuation marks (or) used to enclose textual material. <i>The three months of coalition government were a lamentable political parenthesis.</i>
peripheral	A peripheral device. <i>Lymphocytes from peripheral blood.</i>
quadrilateral	A four-sided figure.
sideways	At an angle. <i>Leaning sideways.</i>
