## Associations of "Side by side" (30 Words)

<b>adjoin</b>	Be next to and joined with (a building, room, or piece of land). <i>Canada <b>adjoins</b> the U S.</i>
<a href="#"><u>apart</u></a>	Not taken into account or excluded from consideration. <i>Joking <b>apart</b> they do a really remarkable job.</i>
<a href="#"><u>aside</u></a>	In a different direction. <i>He pushed his plate <b>aside</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>away</u></a>	An away match or win. <i>Sent the children <b>away</b> to boarding school.</i>
<b>bevel</b>	Cut a bevel on shape to a bevel. <i>A very small 45 <b>bevel</b> is ground on the top surface.</i>
<b>digression</b>	A message that departs from the main subject. <i>Let s return to the main topic after that brief <b>digression</b>.</i>
<b>distal</b>	Situated away from the centre of the body or from the point of attachment. <i>The <b>distal</b> zone is characterized by pyroclastic flow deposits.</i>
<b>edge</b>	Provide with an edge. <i>He had an <b>edge</b> on the competition.</i>
<a href="#"><u>exterior</u></a>	A person’s behaviour and demeanour, especially when at variance with their true character. <i><b>Exterior</b> noise.</i>
<a href="#"><u>external</u></a>	Happening or arising or located outside or beyond some limits or especially surface. <i>For <b>external</b> application only.</i>
<b>extremity</b>	The outermost or farthest region or point. <i>The peninsula s western <b>extremity</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>facade</u></a>	A showy misrepresentation intended to conceal something unpleasant. <i>Her flawless public <b>facade</b> masked private despair.</i>

<b>far</b>	Distant from a point seen as central; extreme. <i>He had not travelled <b>far</b>.</i>
<b>flank</b>	A cut of meat from the flank of an animal. <i>Cherry red sofas <b>flanked</b> the enormous fireplace.</i>
<b>lateral</b>	Involving lateral thinking. <i>Cut back all the <b>laterals</b> to within two buds of the main stem.</i>
<b>laterally</b>	In a way that involves lateral thinking. <i>Use slide steps to move <b>laterally</b>.</i>
<b>left</b>	Location near or direction toward the left side i.e. the side to the north when a person or object faces east. <i>The batter <b>flied</b> out to <b>left</b>.</i>
<b>margin</b>	A line ruled on paper to mark off a margin. <i>The <b>margin</b> of victory.</i>
<b>marginal</b>	Of questionable or minimal quality. <i>She is defending a key <b>marginal</b> for the Tories.</i>
<b>marginally</b>	To only a limited extent; slightly. <i>He s <b>marginally</b> worse than he was.</i>
<b>nearby</b>	Not far away in relative terms. <i>His four sisters live <b>nearby</b>.</i>
<b>northern</b>	(of a wind) blowing from the north. <i>She had a broad <b>northern</b> accent.</i>
<b>oblique</b>	An oblique muscle. <i>An <b>oblique</b> abdominal muscle.</i>
<b>outermost</b>	Situated at the farthest possible point from a center. <i>The <b>outermost</b> layer of the earth.</i>
<b>outwardly</b>	In outward appearance. <i><b>Outwardly</b> featureless modern offices.</i>
<b>parenthesis</b>	Either of two punctuation marks (or) used to enclose textual material. <i>The three months of coalition government were a lamentable political <b>parenthesis</b>.</i>
<b>peripheral</b>	A peripheral device. <i>Lymphocytes from <b>peripheral</b> blood.</i>
<b>quadrilateral</b>	A four-sided figure.
<b>sideways</b>	At an angle. <i>Leaning <b>sideways</b>.</i>
