# **Conjugate Siege**

## Siege in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



SingularPluralI siegeWe siegeYou siegeYou siegeHe/She/It siegesThey siege

#### **Siege in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am sieging	We <b>are sieging</b>
You <b>are sieging</b>	You <b>are sieging</b>
He/She/It is sieging	They are sieging

#### **Siege in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have sieged	We have sieged
You <b>have sieged</b>	You have sieged
He/She/It has sieged	They have sieged

#### **Siege in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been sieging	We have been sieging
You <b>have been sieging</b>	You have been sieging
He/She/It has been sieging	They have been sieging

#### Siege in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>sieged</b>	We <b>sieged</b>
You <b>sieged</b>	You <b>sieged</b>
He/She/It <b>sieged</b>	They $\boldsymbol{sieged}$

#### Siege in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was sieging	We were sieging
You <b>were sieging</b>	You were sieging
He/She/It was sieging	They were sieging

## **Siege in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had sieged	We <b>had sieged</b>
You <b>had sieged</b>	You <b>had sieged</b>
He/She/It had sieged	They had sieged

## **Siege in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been sieging	We had been sieging
You <b>had been sieging</b>	You had been sieging
He/She/It had been sieging	They had been sieging

## Siege in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will siege	We <b>will siege</b>
You <b>will siege</b>	You <b>will siege</b>
He/She/It will siege	They will siege

## Siege in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be sieging	We will be sieging
You <b>will be sieging</b>	You will be sieging
He/She/It will be sieging	They will be sieging

## **Siege in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have siegedWe will have siegedYou will have siegedYou will have siegedHe/She/It will have siegedThey will have sieged

## **Siege in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been sieging	We <b>will have been sieging</b>
You <b>will have been sieging</b>	You <b>will have been sieging</b>
He/She/It will have been sieging	They will have been sieging
