### The Forms of Signal

Infinitive	to signal
Present Tense	signal / signals
Past Tense	signalled (uk) or signaled (us)
Present Participle	signalling (uk) or signaling (us)
Past Participle	signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

# **Conjugate Signal**

#### Signal in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>signal</b>	We <b>signal</b>
You <b>signal</b>	You <b>signal</b>
He/She/It <b>signals</b>	They <b>signal</b>

#### Signal in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am signalling (uk) or signaling (us)	We are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)
You <b>are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)</b>	You <b>are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>is signalling (uk) or signaling</b> (us)	They <b>are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)</b>

### **Signal in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	We have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)
You have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	You have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)
He/She/It <b>has signalled (uk) or signaled</b> (us)	They have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

### **Signal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been signalling (uk) or signaling	We <b>have been signalling (uk) or</b>
(us)	signaling (us)
You <b>have been signalling (uk) or</b>	You <b>have been signalling (uk) or</b>
signaling (us)	signaling (us)
He/She/It <b>has been signalling (uk) or</b>	They <b>have been signalling (uk) or</b>
signaling (us)	signaling (us)

### Signal in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	We <b>signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>
You <b>signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>	You <b>signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>
He/She/It signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	They signalled (uk) or signaled (us)



### Signal in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was signalling (uk) or signaling (us)	We were signalling (uk) or signaling (us)
You <b>were signalling (uk) or signaling (us)</b>	You <b>were signalling (uk) or signaling</b> (us)
He/She/It <b>was signalling (uk) or signaling</b> (us)	They <b>were signalling (uk) or signaling</b> (us)

### **Signal in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	We had signalled (uk) or signaled (us)
You <b>had signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>	You <b>had signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>had signalled (uk) or signaled</b> (us)	They had signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

### **Signal in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been signalling (uk) or signaling	We <b>had been signalling (uk) or signaling</b>
(us)	(us)
You <b>had been signalling (uk) or signaling</b>	You <b>had been signalling (uk) or</b>
(us)	signaling (us)
He/She/It <b>had been signalling (uk) or</b>	They <b>had been signalling (uk) or</b>
signaling (us)	signaling (us)

#### Signal in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will signal</b>	We <b>will signal</b>
You <b>will signal</b>	You <b>will signal</b>
He/She/It will signal	They will signal

#### **Signal in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will be signalling (uk) or signaling (us)	We <b>will be signalling (uk) or signaling</b> (us)
You <b>will be signalling (uk) or signaling</b>	You <b>will be signalling (uk) or signaling</b>
(us)	(us)
He/She/It <b>will be signalling (uk) or</b>	They <b>will be signalling (uk) or signaling</b>
signaling (us)	(us)

## Signal in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)	We <b>will have signalled (uk) or signaled</b> (us)
You <b>will have signalled (uk) or signaled</b> (us)	You <b>will have signalled (uk) or signaled</b> (us)
He/She/It <b>will have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)</b>	They will have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

### **Signal in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been signalling (uk) or	We <b>will have been signalling (uk) or</b>
signaling (us)	signaling (us)
You <b>will have been signalling (uk) or</b>	You <b>will have been signalling (uk) or</b>
signaling (us)	signaling (us)
He/She/It <b>will have been signalling (uk) or signaling (us)</b>	They will have been signalling (uk) or signaling (us)
