Signal in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am signalling (uk) or signaling (us)

You are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)

He/She/It is signalling (uk) or signaling (us)

They are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)

They are signalling (uk) or signaling (us)

Signal in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

You have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

He/She/It has signalled (uk) or signaled
(us)

They have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

They have signalled (uk) or signaled (us)

Signal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been signalling (uk) or signaling We have been signalling (uk) or
