## The Forms of Sin

Infinitive	<b>to sin</b>
Present Tense	<b>sin / sins</b>
Past Tense	<b>sinned</b>
Present Participle	<b>sinning</b>
Past Participle	<b>sinned</b>

## Conjugate Sin

**Sin in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>sin</b>	We <b>sin</b>
You <b>sin</b>	You <b>sin</b>
He/She/It <b>sins</b>	They <b>sin</b>

## **Sin in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am sinning</b>	We <b>are sinning</b>
You <b>are sinning</b>	You <b>are sinning</b>
He/She/It <b>is sinning</b>	They <b>are sinning</b>

## **Sin in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have sinned</b>	We <b>have sinned</b>
You <b>have sinned</b>	You <b>have sinned</b>
He/She/It <b>has sinned</b>	They <b>have sinned</b>

## **Sin in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been sinning</b>	We <b>have been sinning</b>
You <b>have been sinning</b>	You <b>have been sinning</b>
He/She/It <b>has been sinning</b>	They <b>have been sinning</b>

## **Sin in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>sinned</b>	We <b>sinned</b>
You <b>sinned</b>	You <b>sinned</b>
He/She/It <b>sinned</b>	They <b>sinned</b>

## **Sin in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was sinning</b>	<b>We were sinning</b>
<b>You were sinning</b>	<b>You were sinning</b>
<b>He/She/It was sinning</b>	<b>They were sinning</b>

**Sin in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had sinned</b>	<b>We had sinned</b>
<b>You had sinned</b>	<b>You had sinned</b>
<b>He/She/It had sinned</b>	<b>They had sinned</b>

**Sin in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been sinning</b>	<b>We had been sinning</b>
<b>You had been sinning</b>	<b>You had been sinning</b>
<b>He/She/It had been sinning</b>	<b>They had been sinning</b>

**Sin in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will sin</b>	<b>We will sin</b>
<b>You will sin</b>	<b>You will sin</b>
<b>He/She/It will sin</b>	<b>They will sin</b>

**Sin in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be sinning</b>	<b>We will be sinning</b>
<b>You will be sinning</b>	<b>You will be sinning</b>
<b>He/She/It will be sinning</b>	<b>They will be sinning</b>

**Sin in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have sinned**

**We will have sinned**

**You will have sinned**

**You will have sinned**

**He/She/It will have sinned**

**They will have sinned**

**Sin in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been sinning**

**We will have been sinning**

**You will have been sinning**

**You will have been sinning**

**He/She/It will have been sinning**

**They will have been sinning**
