<b>powerfully built</b>	Strong enough to knock down or overwhelm.
<b>rugged</b>	Topographically very uneven. <i>With a house full of boys you have to have <b>rugged</b> furniture.</i>
<b>strapping</b>	Muscular and heavily built. <i>They had three <b>strapping</b> sons.</i>
<b>stringy</b>	(of meat) full of sinews; especially impossible to chew. <i>He had the thin <b>stringy</b> look of a rider.</i>
<b>strong</b>	Relating to or denoting the strongest of the known kinds of force between particles which acts between nucleons and other hadrons when closer than about 10 cm so binding protons in a nucleus despite the repulsion due to their charge and which conserves strangeness parity and isospin. <i>A <b>strong</b> man.</i>
<b>sturdy</b>	(of a person or their body) strongly and solidly built. <i>The bike is <b>sturdy</b> enough to cope with bumpy tracks.</i>
<b>tendinous</b>	Consisting of or resembling tendons. <i>A band of muscular and <b>tendinous</b> fibres.</i>

<b>unchewable</b>	(of meat) full of sinews; especially impossible to chew.
<b>well built</b>	Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
<b>well knit</b>	Resulting favorably.
<b>well muscled</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.

<b>muscle</b>	A muscle or muscles when well developed or prominently visible under the skin. <i>He was eventually <b>muscled</b> out of the market.</i>
<b>muscular</b>	Having a robust muscular body build characterized by predominance of structures bone and muscle and connective tissue developed from the embryonic mesodermal layer. <i>A <b>muscular</b> economy.</i>
<b>omnipotent</b>	(of a deity) having unlimited power. <i>God is described as <b>omnipotent</b> and benevolent.</i>
<b>ossify</b>	Become rigid or fixed in attitude or position; cease developing. <i>These tracheal cartilages may <b>ossify</b>.</i>
<b>potent</b>	Capable of copulation. <i><b>Potent</b> liquor.</i>
<b>powerful</b>	Possessing physical strength and weight rugged and powerful. <i>It is <b>powerful</b> humid.</i>
<b>puissant</b>	Powerful. <i>He would become a <b>puissant</b> man.</i>

<b>regnant</b>	Reigning; ruling. <i>The <b>regnant</b> belief.</i>
<b>strong</b>	Relating to or denoting the strongest of the known kinds of force between particles which acts between nucleons and other hadrons when closer than about 10 cm so binding protons in a nucleus despite the repulsion due to their charge and which conserves strangeness parity and isospin. <i>The company was in a <b>strong</b> position to negotiate a deal.</i>
<b>superhuman</b>	Having or showing exceptional ability or powers. <i><b>Superhuman</b> beings.</i>
<b>superman</b>	A US cartoon, TV, and film character having great strength, the ability to fly, and other extraordinary powers. <i>Appearing in that number of races would have taxed the strength of a <b>superman</b>.</i>
<b>tendinous</b>	Consisting of or resembling tendons. <i>The <b>tendinous</b> portion of the hamstring.</i>
