| strong | Relating to or denoting the strongest of the known kinds of force between particles which acts between nucleons and other hadrons when closer than about 10 cm so binding protons in a nucleus despite the repulsion due to their charge and which conserves strangeness parity and isospin. <i>A strong man.</i> |
| sturdy | (of a person or their body) strongly and solidly built. <i>The bike is sturdy enough to cope with bumpy tracks.</i> |
| tendinous | Consisting of or resembling tendons. <i>A band of muscular and tendinous fibres.</i> |
