The Forms of Sing

Infinitive	to sing
Present Tense	sing / sings
Past Tense	sang
Present Participle	singing
Past Participle	sung or (archaic) sungen

Conjugate Sing

Sing in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **sing** We **sing**
You **sing** You **sing**
He/She/It **sings** They **sing**

Sing in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am singing** We **are singing**
You **are singing** You **are singing**
He/She/It **is singing** They **are singing**

Sing in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have sung or (archaic) sungen** We **have sung or (archaic) sungen**
You **have sung or (archaic) sungen** You **have sung or (archaic) sungen**
He/She/It **has sung or (archaic) sungen** They **have sung or (archaic) sungen**

Sing in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been singing** We **have been singing**
You **have been singing** You **have been singing**
He/She/It **has been singing** They **have been singing**

Sing in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **sang** We **sang**
You **sang** You **sang**
He/She/It **sang** They **sang**

Sing in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was singing We were singing
You were singing You were singing
He/She/It was singing They were singing

Sing in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had sung or (archaic) sungen We had sung or (archaic) sungen
You had sung or (archaic) sungen You had sung or (archaic) sungen
He/She/It had sung or (archaic) sungen They had sung or (archaic) sungen

Sing in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been singing We had been singing
You had been singing You had been singing
He/She/It had been singing They had been singing

Sing in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will sing We will sing
You will sing You will sing
He/She/It will sing They will sing

Sing in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be singing We will be singing
You will be singing You will be singing
He/She/It will be singing They will be singing

Sing in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

I will have sung or (archaic) sungen
You will have sung or (archaic) sungen
He/She/It will have sung or (archaic) sungen

Plural

We will have sung or (archaic) sungen
You will have sung or (archaic) sungen
They will have sung or (archaic) sungen

Sing in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I will have been singing
You will have been singing
He/She/It will have been singing

Plural

We will have been singing
You will have been singing
They will have been singing
