- located** Situated in a particular spot or position.
*Valuable centrally **located** urban land.*
- placed** Put in position in relation to other things.
*Strategically **placed** artillery.*
- set** Set down according to a plan.
*A carefully laid table with places **set** for four people.*



Usage Examples of "Situated" as an adjective

- *Nicely situated on a quiet riverbank.*

- allotted** Given as a task.
*Her **allotted** chores.*
- arranged** Deliberately arranged for effect.
*Haphazardly **arranged** interlobular septa.*
- below** Below deck.
*See **below**.*
- coaster** A ship used to carry cargo along the coast from port to port.
*A West **coaster**.*
- downstairs** Situated downstairs.
*The **downstairs** or downstair phone.*
- emancipation** The freeing of someone from slavery.
*The social and political **emancipation** of women.*

emend	Alter (something that is incorrect. <i>The year of his death might need to be emended to 652.</i>
equipped	Provided with whatever is necessary for a purpose (as furniture or equipment or authority. <i>A well equipped playground.</i>
fixing	Restraint that attaches to something or holds something in place. <i>Problems in need of fixing.</i>
furnished	Provided with whatever is necessary for a purpose (as furniture or equipment or authority. <i>A full sized fully furnished apartment.</i>
ideally	In the best possible way; perfectly. <i>Her experience makes her ideally suited to the job.</i>
in	Of the tide rising or at its highest level. <i>Took the in bus.</i>
inside	On the inside. <i>In winter we play inside.</i>
jell	(of a project or idea) take a definite form or begin to work well. <i>We went out there and tried to win but we just didn't jell.</i>
lay	Used with an abstract noun so that the phrase formed has the same meaning as the verb related to the noun used e g lay the blame on means to blame. <i>Lay a fire.</i>
locate	Situate in a particular place. <i>Can you locate your cousins in the Midwest.</i>
located	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Valuable centrally located urban land.</i>
location	The action of locating someone or something. <i>They shot the film on location in Nevada.</i>
locus	The scene of any event or action (especially the place of a meeting). <i>It is impossible to specify the exact locus in the brain of these neural events.</i>
match	Make equal uniform corresponding or matching. <i>He always carries matches to light his pipe.</i>
matching	Equal in number or amount; equivalent. <i>The college will provide matching funds to complete the project.</i>
place	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>Occupation structures a person's place in society.</i>

preparation	A note that produces a dissonant chord is first heard in a consonant chord. <i>Preparations for the ceremony had begun.</i>
put	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>He put all his efforts into this job.</i>
ready	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>A ready source of cash.</i>
set	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <i>My book will be typeset nicely.</i>
settled	Established or decided beyond dispute or doubt. <i>A period of settled weather.</i>
situate	Situated. <i>The pilot light is usually situated at the front of the boiler.</i>
throughout	Used to refer to cited works. <i>I am grateful for the way in which those who attended the inquiry conducted themselves throughout.</i>
within	On the inside. <i>Enquire within.</i>
