# **Conjugate Skall**

## Skall in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>skall</b>	We <b>skall</b>
You <b>skall</b>	You <b>skall</b>
He/She/It <b>skalls</b>	They <b>skall</b>

### **Skall in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am skalling	We <b>are skalling</b>
You <b>are skalling</b>	You <b>are skalling</b>
He/She/It is skalling	They are skalling

#### **Skall in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have skalled	We have skalled
You have skalled	You have skalled
He/She/It has skalled	They have skalled

#### **Skall in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been skalling	We have been skalling
You <b>have been skalling</b>	You have been skalling
He/She/It has been skalling	They have been skalling

## **Skall in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>skalled</b>	We <b>skalled</b>
You <b>skalled</b>	You <b>skalled</b>
He/She/It <b>skalled</b>	They $\boldsymbol{skalled}$

### **Skall in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was skalling	We <b>were skalling</b>
You were skalling	You were skalling
He/She/It was skalling	They were skalling

#### **Skall in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had skalled	We <b>had skalled</b>
You <b>had skalled</b>	You <b>had skalled</b>
He/She/It had skalled	They had skalled

### **Skall in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been skalling	We had been skalling
You <b>had been skalling</b>	You had been skalling
He/She/It had been skalling	They had been skalling

## **Skall in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will skall	We <b>will skall</b>
You <b>will skall</b>	You <b>will skall</b>
He/She/It will skall	They will skall

## **Skall in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be skalling	We <b>will be skalling</b>
You <b>will be skalling</b>	You <b>will be skalling</b>
He/She/It will be skalling	They will be skalling

#### **Skall in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have skalledWe will have skalledYou will have skalledYou will have skalledHe/She/It will have skalledThey will have skalled

#### **Skall in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been skalling	We <b>will have been skalling</b>
You <b>will have been skalling</b>	You <b>will have been skalling</b>
He/She/It will have been skalling	They will have been skalling
